



The ULBs have submitted the Component and subcomponent wise fund claim along with their MPR for the month of January. The fund claim of the ULBs have verified with the MIS and MPR. It is observed that the ULBs have claimed as per their requirement. Therefore we may process the claim for releasing the fund to the respective ULBs for successful implementation of the NULM programme. The subcomponent wise use of fund is mentioned below which may help the ULBs to utilise the fund smoothly.

- 1. Revolving fund to the SHGs: The ULBs may release the amount of RF @ Rs 10,000/ Per SHG to their saving bank account (who has reached at the age of at least 3 Months from the date of formation).
- 2. Revolving fund to the ALFs: As per Claim and MIS report RF may be released for ALF who have registered under society registration act and opened their saving bank account in a bank branch.
- **3. Fund for Resource Organisation:- first Instalment** The amount @ Rs.2500/- Per SHG may be released to the RO after reviewing the activities like Formation of SHGs; Opening of savings Bank account of the SHGs, RF released to the savings bank account of SHGs & ALF and link the SHGs with the ALF.

Second Instalment The amount @ Rs.2500/- Per SHG may be released to the RO after reviewing the activities like SHG and members of the SHGs and other details data entry in the MIS portal, Bank Credit Linkage of the SHGs and update the same information in the MIS portal. The ALF must follow the rules like Regular Meeting (At least one meeting in a month), Regular lending to the member SHGs, Regular Repayment of Loan, Regular Book Keeping (for maintenance of ALF accounts) and Regular monitoring of the activities of the SHGs (Mainly *Panchasutra*).

Third Instalment The amount @ Rs.2500/- Per SHG may be released to the RO after reviewing the activities like management of fund of the SHGs including the fund of the Cash Credit Account, disbursement of Cash Credit loan amount to the members of the SHGs, Panchasutra must be well maintained by the SHGs. The ALF must follow the rules like Regular Meeting (At least one meeting in a month), Regular lending to the member SHGs, Regular Repayment of Loan, Regular Book Keeping (for maintenance of ALF accounts) and Regular monitoring of the activities of the SHGs (Mainly Panchasutra).

4. Printing of Books account of the SHGs and Federations: - The fund @ Rs. 69100/- for 100 Groups may be allotted to the ULBs for printing of Books of account of the SHGs and ALF in the prescribed format.

For ALF Cash Book, general Ledger, Meeting resolution Book and Loan ledger, Pass book of the groups are required only.

- 5. Basic Orientation Training (BOT) for the members of the SHGs: the members of the SHGs are the participants of Basic Orientation Training and each batch of the training should consist of maximum 40 trainees. In this regard, ULBs are requested to train 3 (three) members (President, Secretary and one general member) from each SHGs for imparting 3days BOT training and 2 members (Book keeper and one general member) for imparting 2 days training on Books of accounts of the SHGs. The training Expenses is mentioned below;
- I. Folder, Reading materials and stationery (Pen, Pencil, eraser & Sharpener):- Rs.100/- Per Trainee (Max Limit)
- II. Lunch & Tea and Snacks:- Rs.210/- For 3 Days (Max Limit)





- III. Mobility Support :- Rs.50 Per Trainee for 3 Days (Max Limit)
- IV. Contingency Support :- Rs.2000/-(Includes Venue Charges, Public Address system and others) (Max Limit)
- V. Resource fees and Conveyance:- Rs.250/- pre session/Resource Person (Maximum Two session by one Resource Person Per Day)
- VI. If Resource person/s of the training is directly linked with the NULM programme (Like CPO/EO, CMMs/APO/Cos/ Accountant) then he/she is not entitled for the resource fee.
- 6. SM&ID fund: The fund may be used for the SHG and SHG related expenses like registration of ALF & CLF, Review meeting with RO/ALFs/CLF/ SHG members, Audit and Renewal Expenditure for ALF and CLF, SHG Grading Camp, taskforce meeting etc. The fund should not be used for the purpose of orientation programme for NULM programme.
- 7. Information Education and Communication: IEC fund may be used for the purpose of IEC activity only. As per order of the authority of SUDA a fund may be released for ALF workshop at the rate of 5000/- per ALF for 50 participants. The fund cannot be used for the purpose of Orientation Programme.
- 8. CB&T Establishment of CMMU: Previously the fund of Rs.50000/- was released to the 67 (2nd phase ULBs) for establishment of CMMU. Further as per order of the authority we may release the amount of Rs.100000/- per ULB for the same purpose.
- 9. Universal Financial Inclusion: The ULB will conduct the Financial Literacy Camp at ULB level. The Lead Bank manager, Bank Branch Manager and other officials of Bank will be the resource person for the Financial Literacy Camp. The ULBs should request to attend the members of the SHGs who have received the credit from Bank Branch.

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The GOI has developed and circulated the component wise programme guideline to implement the NULM programme at SMMU and CMMU level. In Mission Document the GOI has given following guidelines for use of A&OE and IEC fund during implementation of the NULM programme;

- 2 percent of the allocation under DAY-NULM can be utilized as A&OE fund at the Centre/State/City levels for administration and other expenses, including monitoring, development and maintenance of database, MIS, e-tracking, evaluation and other activities.
- 3 percent of the allocation under DAY-NULM can be utilized as IEC fund at the Centre/State/City levels for the purpose of IEC.

In the Capacity Building and Training (CB&T) guideline it is clearly mentioned that the overall expenditure on CB&T component including technical support at National, State and City levels and training and other capacity building support for Mission Management Units (MMUs) at the National, State and City levels shall not exceed 12% of the total allocation under DAY-NULM.

Again, in Capacity Building and Training (CB&T) guideline it is also mentioned that maximum 40% of the total salary paid to the technical experts can be utilized at SMMU and CMMU for TA, DA expenses for the technical expert and for office support (viz., accountant, data entry operator, multi-tasking officials etc.). Rates for TA/DA for travel, accommodation, and food etc. for technical experts will be fixed by the respective MMUs.

On the basis of approved annual target the GOI allocates fund to the states. To implement the programme the GOI release fund on the basis of utilization of previous fund. In the sanction order of fund the GOI never mention the components and subcomponents wise heads of account. The state utilizes the fund on the basis of prescribed guideline of NULM programme.

But since inception of the programme the SMMU has been releasing component and sub component wise fund to the ULBs. After utilization of fund the ULBs are submitting Component and subcomponent wise utilization certificate.

Now it is found that in some components and subcomponents funds are exhausted fully. On the other hand in some heads funds are lying idle. Therefore for optimum utilization of fund we may release fund on demand basis to the ULBs along with a guideline to use the fund.

To get rid out of the problem, we may introduce the Statement of Expenditure (SOE) which may be submitted by the ULB within 10th of each month. The SOE may be treated as Utilization Certificate for fund under NULM. As per the available fund balance in SOE we may release fund to the ULBs by 20th of each month (decision taken in meeting). If the above mentioned process is followed by us, then we may get the following results which are as follows;





- 1. Faster implementation of scheme
- 2. Optimum utilization of fund due to decentralization of power for utilization of component wise fund.
- 3. Quick release of fund to the ULBs.
- 4. Avoid procedural delay

The above mentioned results may induce the smooth implementation of the NULM programme which may give better result.

The proposal for release of pool fund is placed for you kind perusal and approval. If the proposal is approved by the authority then we may communicate the process and guideline to the ULBs.

- 1. The physical report to be entered by the ULB directly in the Google Form already shared through the link. The hardcopy of template physical on the CP Side as ('Flagged-A'). The data reported in this template should be completely in conformity / sync with the data entered in the MIS portal of NULM. The MPR for the physical achievement is to be analyzed through a software / desktop application to be developed in house from the SMMU. This desktop application is to be developed within April, 2019. The reports of the application will based on the SPARK parameters as developed by GOI.
- 2. The financial report again in a Google Form and the link to be shared to the ULBs is to be reported every month. The hardcopy of template pictor on the CP Side as ('Flagged-B'). The proposed financial report envisages to capture the following parameters.
 - Opening Balance as on the first day of the financial year
 - Fund received between the first day of the financial year and the month of reporting
 - Totally availability of fund (summing up item 1 & 2 above)
 - Expenditure during the month under reporting
 - Cumulative expenditure between the 1st day of the financial year and the month under reporting.
 - Utilization up to the month under reporting
 - Balance Fund up to the month under reporting
 - Further requisition of Fund.

All the above parameters are to be reported component wise.

Based on the financial report (monthly) SMMU will release fund within 20th of every month subject to submission of both physical and financial reports by ULB within 10th of every month.

If approved, this reporting arrangement may be shared to ULBs and may take effect from the reporting month of April, 2019 (For 1st reporting month of F.Y. 2019-2020)
