

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) is an autonomous body established under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. FSSAI is responsible for protecting and promoting public health through the regulation and supervision of food safety.

Quality Assurance:- FSSAI has been mandated to perform various functions related to quality and standards of food.

The FSSAI has prescribed standards for following food products:

- Dairy products and analogues
- Fats, oils and fat emulsions
- Fruits and vegetable products
- Cereal and cereal products
- Meat and meat products
- Fish and fish products
- Sweets & confectionery
- Sweetening agents including honey
- Salt, spices, condiments and related products
- Beverages, (other than dairy and fruits & vegetables based)
- Other food product and ingredients
- Proprietary food
- Irradiation of food

State License :- As the members of SHGs / ALFs / and CLFs under NULM programme has been started various types of marketable food productions in their own . Now it is important to register all food products for quality control under FSSAI licensing /registration under State License which will help SHGs to unleash their capabilities to generate meaningful and sustainable livelihoods .

So, under this circumstance , a letter may be sent to the Joint Secretary , Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) , Health & Family Welfare Department , Government

of West Bengal for the information and assistance for the licensing under FSSAI.




