- I. Whether the concerned respondent municipal authorities ought not to have created a situation where the petitioner being the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality is debarred from continuing her said job without any rhyme or reason?
- II. Whether the concerned respondent authorities should have taken due and concrete steps to ensure the petitioners' service as the Assistant Project Officer is continued without any interruption?
- III. Whether the concerned respondent authorities should have acted in a fair manner in handling the said issue of the petitioner?
- Whether the petitioner should not have been illegally IV. removed from the post of full time Assistant Project Officer of the Arambagh Municipality when there exist no proceeding and/or punishment against the petitioner for the said job done as the same is not permissible under the referred memorandums issued by the Government of West Bengal from time to time and as such the said removal is absolutely provisions said illegal and de-hors the the memorandums?
- V. For that the State Government was also well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers as such the Government had decided and also given effect time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Govt. of West Bengal issued a Govt. Order being No. 2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010 which the petitioner was deprived of the advantages thereto.

The humble petition on behalf of the petitioner abovenamed –

Most Respectfully Sheweth:

- 1. Your petitioner states that the petitioner is a Law abiding and peace loving citizen of India and resides at the address as mentioned in the cause title of the instant Application.
- Your petitioner states that the petitioner was appointed as a 'Community Organizer' of the Arambagh Municipality under the program of Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rojgar Yojna (SJSRY) presently known as National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM), a project of the Central Government, in the year 1999. Since December, 2008 the petitioner has been engaged as a Town Project Officer of Arambagh Municipality, nomenclature of which has changed from a Town Project Officer to Assistant Project Officer on an from the day the

SJSRY scheme was restructure as NULM and till date the petitioner has been working continuously in the said post with utmost satisfaction of the respondent authorities.

Photocopies of the engagement letters and restructure scheme are annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/1".

- 3. Your petitioner states that since the said posts of Community Organizer- Town Project Officer- Assistant Project Officer was a contractual post from its inception and it is continued to be so, the petitioner was given subsequent extensions of the said initial contract.
- 4. Your petitioner states that the petitioner has been engaged as a TPO and subsequently as an APO and have been directed to take part in several programs referred to as orientation programs with the State Urban Development Agency for obtaining due and proper training from time to time. Letters regarding such reference of participation in those programs are of utmost importance to that of the petitioner.

Photocopy of the letter dated 13.07.2016 and 15.07.2016 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P-2".

Your petitioner states that the State Government was also 5. well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers, as such the Government had decided and also given effect from time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However, considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Government of West Bengal issued a Government Order being No.2966-F(P) dated 23rd April 2010 to increase the wages of the contractual employees amongst others who are engaged and serving the concern offices for long period. According to the said circular the contractual employees were given with a minimum security in their services by fixing the age of retirement at 60 years and thereby would receive a final honorarium of Rs. 1,00,000/- at the time of such retirement.

Photocopy of the G.O. dated 23rd April 2010 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/3".

6. Your petitioner states that such Government Circular was substantiated by two subsequent notifications one dated 25.02.2011 being No. 113/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 and the second dated 31.03.2011 being No. 145/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010. These notifications specifically suggests that no new appointments in the posts of Town Project Officer will be made until further orders and it was further notified that the existing incumbents holding the posts who were engaged as per Government Orders issued from the department from time to time, will continue in their posts until further orders with various other guidelines.

Photocopies of the notifications dated 25.02.2011 and 31.03.2011 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/4" collectively.

7. Your petitioner states by a subsequent Memorandum being No. 9008-F (P) dated 16.09.2011 the Finance Department to the Government of West Bengal had laid down several subsequent benefits to a casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner.

The photocopy of the said memorandum being No. 9008 F (P) dated 16.09.2011 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/5".

8. Your petitioner states that by a subsequent Memorandum being No. 4011-F (P) dated 20.05.2013 the Government of West Bengal had enhanced the remuneration of Casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner.

The photocopy of the Memorandum being No.4011-F (P) dated 20.05.2013 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/6".

No.1107-F (P) dated 25.02.2016 the Government of West Bengal had set forth enhancement of remuneration of casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner. It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner is entitled to benefits of all the above referred Memorandum issued by the Government of West Bengal as welfare state.

The photocopy of the Memorandum dated 25.02.2016 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/7".

10. Your petitioner states that by Memorandum dated 01.03.16 issued by State Urban Development Agency in respect of enhancement of consolidated monthly honorarium it has

been categorically held that the Assistant Project Officer who were engaged under the erstwhile SJSRY Scheme would continue there function under the NULM Scheme and as such contentions of the respondent authorities in removing the petitioner from said post of Assistant Project Officer is nothing but an act of disrespect to the several Memorandums issued by Government of West Bengal and other authorities.

Photocopy of the Memorandum dated 01.03.2016 is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/8"

as a Community Organizer of the said Municipality in the year 1999 and subsequently as an Assistant Project Officer has been carrying on with her relentless job of organizing the downtrodden people residing under the said municipality by taking various projects of the Central Government to the doorsteps of the have-nots with utmost satisfaction of her superiors and the beneficiaries and in doing so has been bestowed with various recommendations by the said municipality.

- 12. Your petitioner states that the petitioner is otherwise well equipped with the nuances of the job of the Assistant Project Officer as the petitioner have opted for various courses prior to her being engaged as the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality.
- 13. Your petitioner states that the petitioner had started with a meager honorarium of Rs.2,000/- (Two thousand) per month in the year 1999 and thereafter, by the efflux of time the petitioner have been paid with a monthly honorarium of Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand) as an admissible honorarium of the Assistant Project Officer under the National Urban Livelihoods Mission is Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand).

The petitioner craves leave to produce the monthly honorarium certificates at the time of hearing.

14. Your petitioner states that surprisingly a show cause notice dated 12.09.2016 was served on the petitioner issued by the Executive Officer of the Arambagh Municipality for being absent from office on 12.09.2016 which was subsequently replied by the petitioner through her letter dated 15.09.2016 with a copy marked to SUDA. Be it mentioned that such

absence of the petitioner was duly intimated to the Chairman by the petitioner before hand.

Photocopy of the show cause letter and reply thereto are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/94".

15. Your petitioner states that the Honorarium of the petitioner as an Assistant Project Officer was not enhanced as per office memorandum as such the petitioner had written to the Chairman of Respondent Municipality by way of letter dated 05.10.2016 and to the association dated 11.03.2017 after which and upon due consideration of the same the respondent Municipality have enhanced the honorarium of the petitioner to its proper worth.

Photocopy of the letter dated 05.10.2016 and 11.03.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/10".

16. Your petitioner states that a certificate dated 09.03.2017 issued by the Chairman Arambagh Municipality speaks for itself about the continuing work that the petitioner has been rendering as an Assistant Project Officer of the Respondent Municipality uninterruptedly and without any break in service.

Photocopy of the letter dated 09.03.2017 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/112".

17. Your petitioner states that after the initial show cause letter dated 12.09.2016, the petitioner was further issued with a show cause letter dated 10.03.2017 on the score of negligence in the duty which was subsequently replied by the letter dated 16.03.2017. It may not be out of place to mention that the initial reference of show cause had not percolated into any proceeding whatsoever against the petitioner which speaks about disproval of the alleged incidents and the subsequent letter of show cause has also not resulted into any proceeding as the honorarium of the petitioner has been paid even after such incidents.

Photocopy of the letters dated 10.03.2017 and 16.03.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/16".12".

18. Your petitioner states that by a letter dated 21.03.2017 issued by the Executive Officer Arambagh Municipality, the petitioner was requested to submit all the relevant files, note sheets, etc. relating to NULM, SBM and ODF from her table to the said officer and was further requested to hand over

the computer installed at her table, which the petitioner as a prudent employee acceded to such request and had handed over all such itenaries on 22.03.2017.

Photocopy of the letter dated 21.03.2017 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/13".

19. Your petitioner states that all on a sudden from the month of June, 2017 the honorarium due and accruable to the petitioner as an APO was not paid to her and for reason best known to the authorities such payment has not being made since then although funds for the petitioner under the head remuneration has been released by SUDA.

Photocopy of the said fund being released by SUDA is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/12".

20. Your petitioner states that the petitioner had made series of representations to the Chairman, Arambagh Municipality seeking redressal of her grievances of non receipt of her honorarium and to have security at her work place which has not been answered till date and as such no steps has been taken by Municipal Authorities.

Photocopy of the representations dated 07.07.2017, 17.07.2017 and 05.08.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/15" collectively.

21. Your petitioner states that since August, 2017 the atrocities of the Municipal Authorities had increased to a higher level, when the petitioner was unfortunately stopped from her signature in the attendance sheet which is subsequent to the non payment of her remuneration. The petitioner having no other alternative left, wrote to the chairman of the respondent municipality on 21.09.2017 seeking payment of remuneration as well as recording of attendance, which has not been answered till date. It is pertinent to mention here that there has been no proceeding whatsoever against the petitioner and no termination of its kind that had occasioned against the petitioner from her post of APO.

Photocopy of the letter is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/15".

22. Your petitioner states that as per the revised guideline of SUDA a performance appraisal report has to be filed with the said agency which calls for several rectifications although in learn that such a report has been forwarded and/or filed by the Executing Officer, Arambagh Municipality signing for the Chairman, stating some negative aspersion against the petitioner which is de-hors the extant scheme of things as, reports of such a nature has to be filed by an incumbent thorough his/her hand unto his immediate hierarchy which would devolve ultimately to SUDA. Here in this case no such report was called for from the petitioner by the Municipality at any point of time and therefore all such remarks made on the allegation report does not have any to stand. The board of councilors had not taken any steps against the petitioner but it is only the Chairman and the Executive Officer who had reported against the petitioner.

It the respondent municipal authorities who had allotted additional work to the petitioner other than her requisite job of an APO such additional work in SBM, ODF etc. has been bestoed to the petitioner by the said municipal authorities which would be evident from the show cause letter issued to the petitioner by the said authorities. It is an unfortunate affair that the petitioner is being subjected to

such operation at the hands of the municipal authorities for allegedly not performing her job of an APO under the NULM Scheme, when it was the said municipal authorities who had given additional tasks to the petitioner of being in-charge in several other additional jobs which speaks about the expertise of the petitioner in many other fields other than being an APO of the said municipality but, the acts of the respondents authorities in making certain remarks against the petitioner is an absolute dichotomy to say the least.

Photocopy of the said report dated 02.06.2017 is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/ 37".

23. Your petitioner states that the illegal wrath of the respondent Municipality had finally came down on the petitioner when in the month of November, 2017 the existing chair and desk of the petitioner at the Municipality was removed, leaving the petitioner in a state of absolute quandary. Although, the petitioner had been rendering her service to the Municipality and to the people at large as an APO even after her remuneration been illegally withheld, but the acts and deeds of Municipalities in exploiting the petitioner in not allowing her to continue in her post of APO

is highly detrimental to say the least moreso, when there exist no termination letter against the petitioner.

It is one of such case where an employee like that of the petitioner has been harassed to its ultimate limit for rendering her job of an APO of the said municipality and also for her relentless continued performance under the NULM (formerly SJSRY) scheme for the past 18 years. The petitioner on the score of her performance had been living upto the expectation of her employer for passed long years and has maintained her own livelihood out of such job but mental agony that the petitioner has faced during the last few months was absolutely unexpected and uncalled for when, the petitioner has all such qualifications of rendering her service to the society as an APO. The petitioner is facing great difficulty in maintaining her family since the petitioner is not being paid with her remuneration since May, 2017 and also not been allowed to continue with her job of an APO since November, 2017

24. Your petitioner states that the petitioner was appointed as a Community Organizer in the year 1999 by the Arambagh Municipality and was subsequently re-employed as Town Project Officer in the year 2008 under the SJSRY Scheme which has changed its nomenclature to NULM and consequent thereto the designation of the petitioner had also changed to Assistant Project Officer. The petitioner has carried on with her job of Assistant Project Officer under the NULM Scheme, but unfortunately to the best knowledge of the respondent Municipality the honorarium of the petitioner was stopped since June, 2017 and the petitioner was debarred from putting her signature in that attendant sheet since August, 2017 followed by taking away her chair and desk from the office in the month of November, 2017. Such an act on the part of the Municipal Authorities is absolutely uncalled for since their has been no proceedings and /or punishment that has been invoked in respect of the petitioner by the said Municipality but surely on the score of arbitrariness, the petitioner has been forced to discontinue her job as an APO although, several notifications and memorandums of the state of West Bengal give rights to the petitioner and such other employees under the state to get the benefit of the welfare activities of a state thoroughly approved by the cabinet. As such, the action activities of the respondent Municipality against the petitioner in forcefully debarring her from continuing her said job as APO is absolutely bad and perverse in the eye of law when there is a clear violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

25. Your petitioner being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the action on the part of the respondents concerned begs to move the instant application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India on the following amongst other:-

GROUNDS

- I. For that the concerned respondent municipal authorities ought not to have created a situation where the petitioner being the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality is debarred from continuing her said job without any rhyme or reason.
- II. For that the concerned respondent authorities should have taken due and concrete steps to ensure the petitioners' service as the Assistant Project Officer is continued without any interruption.
- III. For that the concerned respondent authorities should have acted in a fair manner in handling the said issue of the petitioner.

- removed from the post of full time Assistant Project Officer of the Arambagh Municipality when there exist no proceeding and/or punishment against the petitioner for the said job done as the same is not permissible under the referred memorandums issued by the Government of West Bengal from time to time and as such the said removal is absolutely illegal and de-hors the provisions of the said memorandums.
- V. For that the State Government was also well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers as such the Government had decided and also given effect time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Govt. of West Bengal issued a Govt. Order being No. 2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010 which the petitioner was deprived of the advantages thereto.
- VI. For that the respondent municipal authorities should not have taken any steps, illegally debarring the petitioner from carrying on with her job of an APO of the said municipality

as there has been no departmental proceedings against the petitioner as she has been carrying on with her said job since 1999 with utmost satisfaction of the employer and also such illegal removal is not liable to be undertaken as the previous Govt. order of the State being No.2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010, No. 113/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 25.02.2016 and No. 145/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 31.03.2011.

- VII. For that the inaction of the concerned respondent authorities is highly illegal, unconstitutional arbitrary and violation of all principal of natural justice and fair play.
- VIII. For that the petitioner was appointed as a Community Organizer in the year 1999 by the Arambagh Municipality and was subsequently re-employed as Town Project Officer in the year 2008 under the SJSRY Scheme which has changed its nomenclature to NULM and consequent thereto the designation of the petitioner had also changed to Assistant Project Officer.
- IX. For that the petitioner has carried on with her job of
 Assistant Project Officer under the NULM Scheme, but
 unfortunately to the best knowledge of the respondent

Municipality the honorarium of the petitioner was stopped since June, 2017 and the petitioner was debarred from putting her signature in that attendant sheet since August, 2017 followed by taking away her chair and desk from the office in the month of November, 2017.

For that such an act of removal of the petitioner on the part X. of the Municipal Authorities is absolutely uncalled for since their has been no proceedings and /or punishment that has been invoked in respect of the petitioner by the said Municipality but surely on the score of arbitrariness, the petitioner has been forced to discontinue her job as an APO although, several notifications and memorandums of the state of West Bengal give rights to the petitioner and such other employees under the state to get the benefit of the welfare activities of a state thoroughly approved by the cabinet. As such, the action activities of the respondent Municipality against the petitioner in forcefully debarring her from continuing her said job as APO is absolutely bad and perverse in the eye of law when there is a clear violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

- XI. For that by Memorandum dated 01.03.16 issued by State Urban Development Agency in respect of enhancement of consolidated monthly honorarium it has been categorically held that the Assistant Project Officer who were engaged under the erstwhile SJSRY Scheme would continue there function under the NULM Scheme and as such contentions of the respondent authorities in removing the petitioner from said post of Assistant Project Officer is nothing but an act of disrespect to the several Memorandums issued by Government of West Bengal and other authorities.
- XII. For that the petitioner in no manner seeks to have permanent status in said municipality but only seeks to have the benefits of the respective Memorandums issued by Government of West Bengal in respect of all contractual/casual/Daily rated workers who are working more than 10 years without any break the condition which the petitioner does fulfills and as such seeks leave under rule 26 of the writ rules of the appellate side of the Hon'ble Court.
- XIII. For that concerned respondent authorities should have taken into consideration the representations served on the authorities by the petitioner.

- 26. Your petitioner states that the records of the instant case are lying outside the ordinary original jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Court.
- 27. Your petitioner humbly submits that there is no other remedy available to it and the prayers as made herein, if allowed shall redress the petitioner's grievances effectively.
- 28. Your petitioner submits that the petitioner had made several representations to the concerned authorities without any results and as such any further demand for justice would be an empty formality.
- 29. Your Petitioner states that due to paucity of time some facts may not have been incorporated and your petitioner craves leave to file supplementary affidavit and your petitioner further crave leave to produce and refer to relevant papers/documents at the time of hearing by way of filing a supplementary affidavit.
- 30. That this application is made bona fide and in the interest of justice.

In the circumstances the petitioner most humbly prays for the following orders:-

- a) The petitioners craves leave before the Hon'ble Court for dispensation of service of notice upon the respondents under Rule 26 of the appellate side writ rules and move the instant application ex-parte for the ends of justice.
- b) A writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to act strictly in accordance with law;
- mandamus directing the respondent authorities their men, agents and subordinates to allow the petitioner to carry on with her job of an Assistant Project Officer of Arambagh Municipality without any hindrances;

- mandamus directing the respondent authorities their men, agents and subordinates to disburse the honorarium due and payable to the petitioner and continue paying the honorarium for the subsequent months without any stoppage;
- e) A writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent authorities their men, agents and subordinates to henceforth disburse the Honorarium of the Assistant Project Officer to the petitioner to the tune of Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand) per month;
- f) A writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities their men,

agents and subordinates to disburse the benefits of a full time Assistant Project Officer by implementing the Government orders of the State being Memorandum No 2966- F (P) 23/04/2010, dated Memorandum being No. 113/ MA/0/ C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 25.02.2011, a memorandum being No.15145/ MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 31.03.11, a Memorandum being No.9008-F(P) dated 16.09.11, a Memorandum being No.4011-F(P) dated 20.05.2013, a memorandum being No.1107-F(P) dated 25.02.2016 and a memorandum dated 0103.2016;

g) A writ in the nature of mandamus directing the

concerned respondents
authorities to consider the
representations already made on
her behalf;

- h) A writ in the nature of certiorari directing the respondents to produce all relevant records before the Hon'ble Court for proper adjudication;
- i) Rule NISI in terms of prayers (a) to (h) above.
- issue directing the respondent municipality to let the petitioner continue as full time Assistant Project Officer of the Arambagh Municipality till the disposal of the instant writ application.

k) Such other or further order or orders as your Lordships may deem fit and proper.

And the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

MEMORANDUM

It has come to the notice of the Government for some time past that for implementation of various schemes/projects of the various Departments of the Government the controlling authorities have been compelled to engaged casual, daily rated workers. In many cases, these employees render service for a substantial period of time even for more than 10 years remaining attached to various Departments of Government. The issue of security of tenure, appropriate emoluments and certain retirement benefits in respect of these employees so engaged on long term basis has been under consideration of the Government for some time past.

After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has now been pleased to order that these casual/daily rated workers who are remaining attached to various establishments of the Government Departments/Directorates/Regional Offices for not less than 10 years as on 01.04.2010 and have rendered service for at least 240 days each year will be allowed the following benefits -

These casual/daily rated workers may remain engaged till their attaining the age of 60. 1.

They will be paid remuneration which will be the minimum pay with corresponding 2. category of workers of Pay Band – 1 (PB-1) i.e. Rs. 6,600/- p.m. with enhancement @ 5% every 3 (Three) years. They will not be entitled to any other allowances. An employee of any other category, if he/she fulfils the required condition will be entitled to a monthly remuneration which will be minimum entry level pay of Pay Band and Grade Pay corresponding to his/her category and the remuneration may be determined in consultation with the Finance Department in the same manner as mentioned above.

After the period of engagement of such an employee ceases on his attaining 60 years of age, he/she will be paid an amount of Rs. 1 lakh as one time cessation of engagement

During the period of engagement, the service of such an employee may be terminated 4. because of involvement in criminal case/misconduct/delinquency/incapacitation etc. or if the employee intends to opt out of the engagement on his own. The enhanced remuneration will be paid w.e.f. 01.06.2010.

The detailed modalities will be worked out soon for Implementation of this order.

From the date of issue of this order no further engagement of such casual/daily rated 5 worker shall be entertained. Officer/Officers responsible for any further engagement of such casual/daily rated worker will be personally liable for violation of this Government order.



Sequentially, till such rime the model code of conduct is in force, and later, till the recruitment rules are finalised for these posts, the Urban Local, Bodies, will not be advised to cause changes in the personnel pattern as it has evolved over the years and as the same has been accepted in the State Cabinet on the recommendation of the Finance Department recently.

MEMORANDUM

In order to provide security of tenure, appropriate emoluments and certain terminal benefits subject to fulfilment of certain conditions to the casual/dally rated/contractual workers who have remained engaged in various Government Establishments for a considerable period of more than 10 years in connection with implementation of various schemes/projects of various Departments of the government two Memorandums vide No. 2966-F(P) dt. 23-04-2010 and No. 11794-F(P) dt. 22-12-2010 were issued by the Government in Finance Department.

The question of making the provisions of the two aforesaid orders more effective and suitable to the convenience of the Government Establishments/Organization has been under active consideration of the Government for some time past.

After careful consideration of the matter and in supersession of the aforesaid orders and all other orders issued by other Departments in the matter, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor, has now been pleased to order that the casual/daily rated/contractual workers, who are remaining attached to various establishments of the Government Departments/ Directorates/Regional Offices/other Organizations for not less than 10 years continuously as on 01-08-2011 and have rendered service for at least 240 days each year will be allowed the following benefits:

The casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have rendered 10 years of service continuously with at least 240 days attendance each year may remain engaged in the same status and capacity till their attaining the age of 60 years.

The continuity of service shall have to be certified by a competent officer not below the rank of Assistant Secretary in the case of a Secretariat Department, Director in the case of a Directorate and Assistant Engineer/S.D.O/B.D.O in the case of Regional Offices. 'The concerned officer, who certifies may be advised to exercise extreme precautions and take assistance of an office of WBA & AS, if necessary.

An entry point basic pay in PB-I i.e. Rs. 6600/- (Rs. 4900 + 1700) p.m. will be admissible to cusual/daily rated/contractual Group 'D' workers as consolidated remuneration, similar entry point pay (entry point pay in the Pay Band plus Grade Pay) will be admissible to casual/daily raled/contractual Group 'C' worker and an employee of any other category, if he/she fulfils the required condition will be entitled to a monthly remuneration which will be minimum entry level pay of Pay Band and Grade Pay corresponding to his/her category and the remuneration may be

determined in consultation with the Finance Department in the same manner as mentioned above.

- (iii) When such casual/daily rated/contractual workers are allowed the entry point basic pay, they will not get any other allowances like dearness allowance, house rent allowance etc. However, their basic pay will be enhanced by 5% after every three years and the three years will be counted by treating the period from 1st August 2011 to 1st July 2012 as completed year for giving effect to 5 per cent increase in basic pay.
- (iv) The remuneration of casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have not yet completed 10-year service will be equivalent to 75% of the remuneration admissible under sub-para (ii) above subject to a minimum of Rs. 5000/- p.m.
- (v) Those casual/daily rated/contractual workers who will complete 10 year service on 1st July every year will come under the purview of this Order provided no such worker if engaged after 01-04-2010 will come under the purview of this Order.
- (vi) A casual/daily rated/contractual worker who will fulfil the conditions as laid down in sub-para (i) above will continue to be engaged in such a manner till he/she attains the age of 60 years when he/she will be paid an amount of Rs. 1 lakh as one time cessation of engagement benefit.
- (vii) A casual/ daily rated/contractual worker may be allowed 30 (thirty) off days a year and a female such worker may be allowed Maternity leave of 180 (one hundred eighty)days in addition to 30 days off as mentioned hereinbefore.
- (viii) A casual/daily rated/contractual worker who is engaged in two different Government Departments but has rendered services for 10 years without a break will come under the purview of this Order.
- engagement of such casual/daily rated/contractual worker will be personally liable for violation of this Order. However, having regard to the exigencies of situation and in order to facilitate smooth running of any project/administration or for serving academic interest where it is absolutely necessary contractual engagement may be made for a very limited period not exceeding 1 (one) year. This engagement shall be made on strict observance of recruitment rules and against sanctioned vacancies. Advertisement shall be published in newspaper and applications shall be invited from eligible candidates to fill up those temporary vacancies. Simultaneously steps should be taken to fill up the vacancies on regular basis following recruitment rules. Such contractual engagement may be renewed from time to time, but not exceeding a total period of 6 (six) years, No claim to regularization of this contractual service in terms of G.O. No. 8305-F dt. 26-09-2005 read with G.O. No. 642-F dt. 24-01-06 shall lie.
 - (x) The provisions of this Order will not be applicable where contractual engagement has been made without any sanctioned post and for any specific project for a very temporary period upto a maximum 6 (six) years or

ang up of the project whichever is earlier. Thus in such cases steps will not be required to be initiated for filling up the posts through regular appointments as per the Recruitment Rules, since the posts are temporary by nature.

#3-

- (xi) During the period of engagement, the service of a casual/daily rated/contractual worker may be terminated because of involvement in criminal case/misconduct/delinquency/incapacitation etc. or if the concerned worker intends to opt out of the engagement on his/her own.
- (xii) The benefit of this Memo will be applicable mutatis mutantis to the Panchayat Bodies/ULBs/ Statutory Bodies.
- (xiii) The casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have already got the benefit with reference to 1st April, 2010 as cut off date will continue to get the benefit in terms of F.D. Memo No. 2966-F(P) dt. 23-04-2010 and No. 11974-F(P) dt. 22-12-2010, while the others will be covered in terms of provisions of this Memo.

The undersigned is further directed to reiterate that henceforth no further engagement of Group 'D' employees, who are engaged in the manner as laid down in F.D. Memo. No. 3727-F dt. 20-05-2009 and paid out of contingency, will be done, on or after 01-04-2010. Officer/Officers responsible for such engagement will be personally liable for violation of this Order.

- (xlv) The final approval will be given by the ACS/Principal Secretary/Secretary as the case may be, of the concerned Department, after exercising necessary checks & balances & ensuring that any ineligible person does not get the benefits of this order.
- (xv) A proforma statement is hereby annexed for supplying information by the respective appointing authority to the Administrative Department.

- I. Whether the concerned respondent municipal authorities ought not to have created a situation where the petitioner being the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality is debarred from continuing her said job without any rhyme or reason?
- II. Whether the concerned respondent authorities should have taken due and concrete steps to ensure the petitioners' service as the Assistant Project Officer is continued without any interruption?
- III. Whether the concerned respondent authorities should have acted in a fair manner in handling the said issue of the petitioner?
- IV. Whether the petitioner should not have been illegally removed from the post of full time Assistant Project Officer of the Arambagh Municipality when there exist no proceeding and/or punishment against the petitioner for the said job done as the same is not permissible under the referred memorandums issued by the Government of West Bengal from time to time and as such the said removal is absolutely illegal and de-hors the provisions of the said memorandums?

For that the State Government was also well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers as such the Government had decided and also given effect time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Govt. of West Bengal issued a Govt. Order being No. 2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010 which the petitioner was deprived of the advantages thereto.

The humble petition on behalf of the petitioner abovenamed –

Most Respectfully Sheweth:

- Your petitioner states that the petitioner is a Law abiding and peace loving citizen of India and resides at the address as mentioned in the cause title of the instant Application.
- Your petitioner states that the petitioner was appointed as a 'Community Organizer' of the Arambagh Municipality under the program of Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rojgar Yojna (SJSRY) presently known as National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM), a project of the Central Government, in the year 1999. Since December, 2008 the petitioner has been engaged as a Town Project Officer of Arambagh Municipality, nomenclature of which has changed from a Town Project Officer to Assistant Project Officer on an from the day the

SJSRY scheme was restructure as NULM and till date the petitioner has been working continuously in the said post with utmost satisfaction of the respondent authorities.

Photocopies of the engagement letters and restructure scheme are annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/1".

- 3. Your petitioner states that since the said posts of Community Organizer- Town Project Officer- Assistant Project Officer was a contractual post from its inception and it is continued to be so, the petitioner was given subsequent extensions of the said initial contract.
- 4. Your petitioner states that the petitioner has been engaged as a TPO and subsequently as an APO and have been directed to take part in several programs referred to as orientation programs with the State Urban Development Agency for obtaining due and proper training from time to time. Letters regarding such reference of participation in those programs are of utmost importance to that of the petitioner.

Photocopy of the letter dated 13.07.2016 and 15.07.2016 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P-2".

5. Your petitioner states that the State Government was also well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers, as such the Government had decided and also given effect from time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However, considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Government of West Bengal issued a Government Order being No.2966-F(P) dated 23rd April 2010 to increase the wages of the contractual employees amongst others who are engaged and serving the concern offices for long period. According to the said circular the contractual employees were given with a minimum security in their services by fixing the age of retirement at 60 years and thereby would receive a final honorarium of Rs. 1,00,000/- at the time of such retirement.

Photocopy of the G.O. dated 23rd April 2010 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/3".

6. Your petitioner states that such Government Circular was substantiated by two subsequent notifications one dated 25.02.2011 being No. 113/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 and the second dated 31.03.2011 being No. 145/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010. These notifications specifically suggests that no new appointments in the posts of Town Project Officer will be made until further orders and it was further notified that the existing incumbents holding the posts who were engaged as per Government Orders issued from the department from time to time, will continue in their posts until further orders with various other guidelines.

Photocopies of the notifications dated 25.02.2011 and 31.03.2011 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/4" collectively.

7. Your petitioner states by a subsequent Memorandum being No. 9008-F (P) dated 16.09.2011 the Finance Department to the Government of West Bengal had laid down several subsequent benefits to a casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner.

The photocopy of the said memorandum being No. 9008 F (P) dated 16.09.2011 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/5".

8. Your petitioner states that by a subsequent Memorandum being No. 4011-F (P) dated 20.05.2013 the Government of West Bengal had enhanced the remuneration of Casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner.

The photocopy of the Memorandum being No.4011-F (P) dated 20.05.2013 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/6".

9. Your petitioner states that by a latest Memorandum being No.1107-F (P) dated 25.02.2016 the Government of West Bengal had set forth enhancement of remuneration of casual/daily rated/contractual workers like that of the petitioner. It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner is entitled to benefits of all the above referred Memorandum issued by the Government of West Bengal as welfare state.

The photocopy of the Memorandum dated 25.02.2016 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/7".

10. Your petitioner states that by Memorandum dated 01.03.16 issued by State Urban Development Agency in respect of enhancement of consolidated monthly honorarium it has

been categorically held that the Assistant Project Officer who were engaged under the erstwhile SJSRY Scheme would continue there function under the NULM Scheme and as such contentions of the respondent authorities in removing the petitioner from said post of Assistant Project Officer is nothing but an act of disrespect to the several Memorandums issued by Government of West Bengal and other authorities.

Photocopy of the Memorandum dated 01.03.2016 is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/8"

as a Community Organizer of the said Municipality in the year 1999 and subsequently as an Assistant Project Officer has been carrying on with her relentless job of organizing the downtrodden people residing under the said municipality by taking various projects of the Central Government to the doorsteps of the have-nots with utmost satisfaction of her superiors and the beneficiaries and in doing so has been bestowed with various recommendations by the said municipality.

- 12. Your petitioner states that the petitioner is otherwise well equipped with the nuances of the job of the Assistant Project Officer as the petitioner have opted for various courses prior to her being engaged as the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality.
- 13. Your petitioner states that the petitioner had started with a meager honorarium of Rs.2,000/- (Two thousand) per month in the year 1999 and thereafter, by the efflux of time the petitioner have been paid with a monthly honorarium of Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand) as an admissible honorarium of the Assistant Project Officer under the National Urban Livelihoods Mission is Rs.15,000/- (fifteen thousand).

The petitioner craves leave to produce the monthly honorarium certificates at the time of hearing.

14. Your petitioner states that surprisingly a show cause notice dated 12.09.2016 was served on the petitioner issued by the Executive Officer of the Arambagh Municipality for being absent from office on 12.09.2016 which was subsequently replied by the petitioner through her letter dated 15.09.2016 with a copy marked to SUDA. Be it mentioned that such

absence of the petitioner was duly intimated to the Chairman by the petitioner before hand.

Photocopy of the show cause letter and reply thereto are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/94".

15. Your petitioner states that the Honorarium of the petitioner as an Assistant Project Officer was not enhanced as per office memorandum as such the petitioner had written to the Chairman of Respondent Municipality by way of letter dated 05.10.2016 and to the association dated 11.03.2017 after which and upon due consideration of the same the respondent Municipality have enhanced the honorarium of the petitioner to its proper worth.

Photocopy of the letter dated 05.10.2016 and 11.03.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/10".

16. Your petitioner states that a certificate dated 09.03.2017 issued by the Chairman Arambagh Municipality speaks for itself about the continuing work that the petitioner has been rendering as an Assistant Project Officer of the Respondent Municipality uninterruptedly and without any break in service.

Photocopy of the letter dated 09.03.2017 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/11 %".

17. Your petitioner states that after the initial show cause letter dated 12.09.2016, the petitioner was further issued with a show cause letter dated 10.03.2017 on the score of negligence in the duty which was subsequently replied by the letter dated 16.03.2017. It may not be out of place to mention that the initial reference of show cause had not percolated into any proceeding whatsoever against the petitioner which speaks about disproval of the alleged incidents and the subsequent letter of show cause has also not resulted into any proceeding as the honorarium of the petitioner has been paid even after such incidents.

Photocopy of the letters dated 10.03.2017 and 16.03.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/ **.12."

18. Your petitioner states that by a letter dated 21.03.2017 issued by the Executive Officer Arambagh Municipality, the petitioner was requested to submit all the relevant files, note sheets, etc. relating to NULM, SBM and ODF from her table to the said officer and was further requested to hand over

the computer installed at her table, which the petitioner as a prudent employee acceded to such request and had handed over all such itenaries on 22.03.2017.

Photocopy of the letter dated 21.03.2017 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/13".

19. Your petitioner states that all on a sudden from the month of June, 2017 the honorarium due and accruable to the petitioner as an APO was not paid to her and for reason best known to the authorities such payment has not being made since then although funds for the petitioner under the head remuneration has been released by SUDA.

Photocopy of the said fund being released by SUDA is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/12".

20. Your petitioner states that the petitioner had made series of representations to the Chairman, Arambagh Municipality seeking redressal of her grievances of non receipt of her honorarium and to have security at her work place which has not been answered till date and as such no steps has been taken by Municipal Authorities. Photocopy of the representations dated 07.07.2017, 17.07.2017 and 05.08.2017 are annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/15" collectively.

21. Your petitioner states that since August, 2017 the atrocities of the Municipal Authorities had increased to a higher level, when the petitioner was unfortunately stopped from her signature in the attendance sheet which is subsequent to the non payment of her remuneration. The petitioner having no other alternative left, wrote to the chairman of the respondent municipality on 21.09.2017 seeking payment of remuneration as well as recording of attendance, which has not been answered till date. It is pertinent to mention here that there has been no proceeding whatsoever against the petitioner and no termination of its kind that had occasioned against the petitioner from her post of APO.

Photocopy of the letter is annexed herewith and marked with the letter "P/1%".

22. Your petitioner states that as per the revised guideline of SUDA a performance appraisal report has to be filed with the said agency which calls for several rectifications although in consonance to said Memorandum the petitioner came to learn that such a report has been forwarded and/or filed by the Executing Officer, Arambagh Municipality signing for the Chairman, stating some negative aspersion against the petitioner which is de-hors the extant scheme of things as, reports of such a nature has to be filed by an incumbent thorough his/her hand unto his immediate hierarchy which would devolve ultimately to SUDA. Here in this case no such report was called for from the petitioner by the Municipality at any point of time and therefore all such remarks made on the allegation report does not have any to stand. The board of councilors had not taken any steps against the petitioner but it is only the Chairman and the Executive Officer who had reported against the petitioner.

It the respondent municipal authorities who had allotted additional work to the petitioner other than her requisite job of an APO such additional work in SBM, ODF etc. has been bestoed to the petitioner by the said municipal authorities which would be evident from the show cause letter issued to the petitioner by the said authorities. It is an unfortunate affair that the petitioner is being subjected to

such operation at the hands of the municipal authorities for allegedly not performing her job of an APO under the NULM Scheme, when it was the said municipal authorities who had given additional tasks to the petitioner of being in-charge in several other additional jobs which speaks about the expertise of the petitioner in many other fields other than being an APO of the said municipality but, the acts of the respondents authorities in making certain remarks against the petitioner is an absolute dichotomy to say the least.

Photocopy of the said report dated 02.06.2017 is annexed hereto and marked with the letter "P/# 17".

23. Your petitioner states that the illegal wrath of the respondent Municipality had finally came down on the petitioner when in the month of November, 2017 the existing chair and desk of the petitioner at the Municipality was removed, leaving the petitioner in a state of absolute quandary. Although, the petitioner had been rendering her service to the Municipality and to the people at large as an APO even after her remuneration been illegally withheld, but the acts and deeds of Municipalities in exploiting the petitioner in not allowing her to continue in her post of APO

is highly detrimental to say the least moreso, when there exist no termination letter against the petitioner.

It is one of such case where an employee like that of the petitioner has been harassed to its ultimate limit for rendering her job of an APO of the said municipality and also for her relentless continued performance under the NULM (formerly SJSRY)scheme for the past 18 years. The petitioner on the score of her performance had been living upto the expectation of her employer for passed long years and has maintained her own livelihood out of such job but mental agony that the petitioner has faced during the last few months was absolutely unexpected and uncalled for when, the petitioner has all such qualifications of rendering her service to the society as an APO. The petitioner is facing great difficulty in maintaining her family since the petitioner is not being paid with her remuneration since May, 2017 and also not been allowed to continue with her job of an APO since November, 2017

24. Your petitioner states that the petitioner was appointed as a Community Organizer in the year 1999 by the Arambagh Municipality and was subsequently re-employed as Town

Project Officer in the year 2008 under the SJSRY Scheme which has changed its nomenclature to NULM and consequent thereto the designation of the petitioner had also changed to Assistant Project Officer. The petitioner has carried on with her job of Assistant Project Officer under the NULM Scheme, but unfortunately to the best knowledge of the respondent Municipality the honorarium of the petitioner was stopped since June, 2017 and the petitioner was debarred from putting her signature in that attendant sheet since August, 2017 followed by taking away her chair and desk from the office in the month of November, 2017. Such an act on the part of the Municipal Authorities is absolutely uncalled for since their has been no proceedings and /or punishment that has been invoked in respect of the petitioner by the said Municipality but surely on the score of arbitrariness, the petitioner has been forced to discontinue her job as an APO although, several notifications and memorandums of the state of West Bengal give rights to the petitioner and such other employees under the state to get the benefit of the welfare activities of a state thoroughly approved by the cabinet. As such, the action activities of the respondent Municipality against the petitioner in forcefully

debarring her from continuing her said job as APO is absolutely bad and perverse in the eye of law when there is a clear violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

25. Your petitioner being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the action on the part of the respondents concerned begs to move the instant application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India on the following amongst other:-

GROUNDS

- I. For that the concerned respondent municipal authorities ought not to have created a situation where the petitioner being the Assistant Project Officer of the said municipality is debarred from continuing her said job without any rhyme or reason.
- II. For that the concerned respondent authorities should have taken due and concrete steps to ensure the petitioners' service as the Assistant Project Officer is continued without any interruption.
- III. For that the concerned respondent authorities should have acted in a fair manner in handling the said issue of the petitioner.

- IV. For that the petitioner should not have been illegally removed from the post of full time Assistant Project Officer of the Arambagh Municipality when there exist no proceeding and/or punishment against the petitioner for the said job done as the same is not permissible under the referred memorandums issued by the Government of West Bengal from time to time and as such the said removal is absolutely illegal and de-hors the provisions of the said memorandums.
- V. For that the State Government was also well aware about the security of the tenure and appropriate emoluments of those casual workers as such the Government had decided and also given effect time to time monetary benefit to contractual employees like that of the petitioner. However considering the above concept as well as service status of the contractual employees like that of the petitioner, of municipalities and corporations of West Bengal, the Department of Finance, Govt. of West Bengal issued a Govt. Order being No. 2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010 which the petitioner was deprived of the advantages thereto.
- VI. For that the respondent municipal authorities should not have taken any steps, illegally debarring the petitioner from carrying on with her job of an APO of the said municipality

as there has been no departmental proceedings against the petitioner as she has been carrying on with her said job since 1999 with utmost satisfaction of the employer and also such illegal removal is not liable to be undertaken as the previous Govt. order of the State being No.2966-F (P) dated 23rd April 2010, No. 113/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 25.02.2016 and No. 145/MA/O/C-9/2A-13/2010 dated 31.03.2011.

- VII. For that the inaction of the concerned respondent authorities is highly illegal, unconstitutional arbitrary and violation of all principal of natural justice and fair play.
- VIII. For that the petitioner was appointed as a Community
 Organizer in the year 1999 by the Arambagh Municipality
 and was subsequently re-employed as Town Project Officer
 in the year 2008 under the SJSRY Scheme which has
 changed its nomenclature to NULM and consequent thereto
 the designation of the petitioner had also changed to
 Assistant Project Officer.
- IX. For that the petitioner has carried on with her job of
 Assistant Project Officer under the NULM Scheme, but
 unfortunately to the best knowledge of the respondent

Municipality the honorarium of the petitioner was stopped since June, 2017 and the petitioner was debarred from putting her signature in that attendant sheet since August, 2017 followed by taking away her chair and desk from the office in the month of November, 2017.

For that such an act of removal of the petitioner on the part X. of the Municipal Authorities is absolutely uncalled for since their has been no proceedings and /or punishment that has been invoked in respect of the petitioner by the said Municipality but surely on the score of arbitrariness, the petitioner has been forced to discontinue her job as an APO although, several notifications and memorandums of the state of West Bengal give rights to the petitioner and such other employees under the state to get the benefit of the welfare activities of a state thoroughly approved by the cabinet. As such, the action activities of the respondent Municipality against the petitioner in forcefully debarring her from continuing her said job as APO is absolutely bad and perverse in the eye of law when there is a clear violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

- VI. For that by Memorandum dated 01.03.16 issued by State
 Urban Development Agency in respect of enhancement of
 consolidated monthly honorarium it has been categorically
 held that the Assistant Project Officer who were engaged
 under the erstwhile SJSRY Scheme would continue there
 function under the NULM Scheme and as such contentions
 of the respondent authorities in removing the petitioner from
 said post of Assistant Project Officer is nothing but an act of
 disrespect to the several Memorandums issued by
 Government of West Bengal and other authorities.
- XII. For that the petitioner in no manner seeks to have permanent status in said municipality but only seeks to have the benefits of the respective Memorandums issued by Government of West Bengal in respect of all contractual/casual/Daily rated workers who are working more than 10 years without any break the condition which the petitioner does fulfills and as such seeks leave under rule 26 of the writ rules of the appellate side of the Hon'ble Court.
- XIII. For that concerned respondent authorities should have taken into consideration the representations served on the authorities by the petitioner.

- 26. Your petitioner states that the records of the instant case are lying outside the ordinary original jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Court.
- 27. Your petitioner humbly submits that there is no other remedy available to it and the prayers as made herein, if allowed shall redress the petitioner's grievances effectively.
- 28. Your petitioner submits that the petitioner had made several representations to the concerned authorities without any results and as such any further demand for justice would be an empty formality.
- 29. Your Petitioner states that due to paucity of time some facts may not have been incorporated and your petitioner craves leave to file supplementary affidavit and your petitioner further crave leave to produce and refer to relevant papers/documents at the time of hearing by way of filing a supplementary affidavit.
- 30. That this application is made bona fide and in the interest of justice.

In the circumstances the petitioner most humbly prays for the following orders:-

- a) The petitioners craves leave before the Hon'ble Court for dispensation of service of notice upon the respondents under Rule 26 of the appellate side writ rules and move the instant application ex-parte for the ends of justice.
- b) A writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to act strictly in accordance with law;
- c) A writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities their men, agents and subordinates to allow the petitioner to carry on with her job of an Assistant Project Officer of Arambagh Municipality without any hindrances;

- mandamus directing the respondent authorities their men, agents and subordinates to disburse the honorarium due and payable to the petitioner and continue paying the honorarium for the subsequent months without any stoppage;

MEMORANDUM

It has come to the notice of the Government for some time past that for implementation of various schemes/projects of the various Departments of the Government the controlling authorities have been compelled to engaged casual, daily rated workers. In many cases, these employees render service for a substantial period of time even for more than 10 years remaining attached to various Departments of Government. The issue of security of tenure, appropriate emoluments and certain retirement benefits in respect of these employees so engaged on long term basis has been under consideration of the Government for some time past.

After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has now been pleased to order that these casual/daily rated workers who are remaining attached to various establishments of the Government Departments/Directorates/Regional Offices for not less than 10 years as on 01.04.2010 and have rendered service for at least 240 days each year will be allowed the following benefits –

1. These casual/daily rated workers may remain engaged till their attaining the age of 60.

- 2. They will be paid remuneration which will be the minimum pay with corresponding category of workers of Pay Band 1 (PB-1) i.e. Rs. 6,600/- p.m. with enhancement @ 5% every 3 (Three) years. They will not be entitled to any other allowances.

 An employee of any other category, if he/she fulfills the required condition will be entitled to a monthly remuneration which will be minimum entry level pay of Pay Band and Grade Pay corresponding to his/her category and the remuneration may be determined in consultation with the Finance Department in the same manner as mentioned above.
- After the period of engagement of such an employee ceases on his attaining 60 years of age, he/she will be paid an amount of Rs. 1 lakh as one time cessation of engagement benefit.
- 4. During the period of engagement, the service of such an employee may be terminated because of involvement in criminal case/misconduct/delinquency/incapacitation etc. or if the employee intends to opt out of the engagement on his own.

 The enhanced remuneration will be paid w.e.f. 01.06.2010.
- The detailed modalities will be worked out soon for implementation of this order.

 5. From the date of issue of this order no further engagement of such casual/dally rated worker shall be entertained. Officer/Officers responsible for any further engagement of such casual/dally rated worker will be personally liable for violation of this Government order.



In order to provide security of tenure, appropriate emoluments and certain terminal benefits subject to fulfilment of certain conditions to the casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have remained engaged in various Government Establishments for a considerable period of more than 10 years in connection with implementation of various schemes/projects of various Departments of the government two Memorandums vide No. 2966-F(P) dt. 23-04-2010 and No. 11794-F(P) dt. 22-12-2010 were issued by the Government in Finance Department.

The question of making the provisions of the two aforesaid orders more effective and suitable to the convenience of the Government Establishments/Organization has been under active consideration of the Government for some time past.

After careful consideration of the matter and in supersession of the aforesaid orders and all other orders issued by other Departments in the matter, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor, has now been pleased to order that the casual/daily rated/contractual workers, who are remaining attached to various establishments of the Government Departments/ Directorates/Regional Offices/other Organizations for not less than 10 years continuously as on 01-08-2011 and have rendered service for at least 240 days each year will be allowed the following benefits:

(i) The casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have rendered 10 years of service continuously with at least 240 days attendance each year may remain engaged in the same status and capacity till their attaining the age of 60 years.

The continuity of service shall have to be certified by a competent officer not below the rank of Assistant Secretary in the case of a Secretariat Department, Director in the case of a Directorate and Assistant Engineer/S.D.O/B.D.O in the case of Regional Offices. The concerned officer, who certifies may be advised to exercise extreme precautions and take assistance of an office of WBA & AS, if necessary.

(ii) An entry point basic pay in PB-I i.e. Rs. 6600/- (Rs. 4900 + 1700) p.m. will be admissible to casual/daily rated/contractual Group 'D' workers as consolidated remuneration, similar entry point pay (entry point pay in the Pay Band plus Grade Pay) will be admissible to casual/daily rated/contractual Group 'C' worker and an employee of any other category, if be/she fulfils the required condition will be entitled to a monthly remuneration which will be minimum entry level pay of Pay Band and Grade Pay corresponding to his/her category and the remuneration may be

determined in consultation with the Finance Department in the same manner as mentioned above.

- (iii) When such casual/daily rated/contractual workers are allowed the entry point basic pay, they will not get any other allowances like dearness allowance, house rent allowance etc. However, their hasic pay will be enhanced by 5% after every three years and the three years will be counted by treating the period from 1st August 2011 to 1st July 2012 as completed year for giving effect to 5 per cent increase in basic pay.
- (iv) The remuneration of casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have not yet completed 10-year service will be equivalent to 75% of the remuneration admissible under sub-para (ii) above subject to a minimum of Rs. 5000/- p.m.
- (v) Those casual/daily rated/contractual workers who will complete 10 year service on 1st July every year will come under the purview of this Order provided, no such worker if engaged after 01-04-2010 will come under the purview of this Order.
- (vi) A casual/daily rated/contractual worker who will fulfil the conditions as laid down in sub-para (i) above will continue to be engaged in such a manner till he/she attains the age of 60 years when he/she will be paid an amount of Rs. 1 lakh as one time cessation of engagement benefit.
- (vii) A casual/daily rated/contractual worker may be allowed 30 (thirty) off days a year and a female such worker may be allowed Maternity leave of 180 (one hundred eighty)days in addition to 30 days off as mentioned hereinbefore.
- (viii) A casual/daily rated/contractual worker who is engaged in two different Government Departments but has rendered services for 10 years without a break will come under the purview of this Order.
- (ix) It is reiterated that Officer/Officers responsible for any further engagement of such casual/daily rated/contractual worker will be personally liable for violation of this Order. However, having regard to the exigencies of situation and in order to facilitate smooth running of any project/administration or for serving academic interest where it is absolutely necessary contractual engagement may be made for a very limited period not exceeding 1 (one) year. This engagement shall be made on strict observance of recruitment rules and against sanctioned vacancies. Advertisement shall be published in newspaper and applications shall be invited from eligible candidates to fill up those temporary vacancies. Simultaneously steps should be taken to fill up the vacancies on regular basis following recruitment rules. Such contractual engagement may be renewed from time to time, but not exceeding a total period of 6 (slx) years. No claim to regularization of this contractual service in terms of G.O. No. 8305-F dt. 26-09-2005 read with G.O. No. 642-F dt. 24-01-06 shall lie.
 - (x) The provisions of this Order will not be applicable where contractual engagement has been made without any sanctioned post and for any specific project for a very temporary period upto a maximum 6 (six) years or

appointments as per the Recruitment Rules, since the posts are temporary by nature.

-F3:-

- (xi) During the period of engagement, the service of a casual/daily rated/contractual worker may be terminated because of involvement in criminal case/misconduct/delinquency/incapacitation etc. or if the concerned worker intends to opt out of the engagement on his/her own.
- (xii) The benefit of this Memo will be applicable mutatis mutandis to the Panchayat Bodies/ULRs/ Statutory Bodies.
- (xiii) The casual/daily rated/contractual workers who have already got the benefit with reference to 1st April, 2010 as cut off date will continue to get the benefit in terms of F.D. Metne No. 2966-F(P) dt. 23-04-2010 and No. 11974-F(P) dt. 22-12-2010, while the others will be covered in terms of provisions of this Memo.

The undersigned is further directed to reiterate that henceforth no further engagement of Group 'D' employees, who are engaged in the manner as laid down in F.D. Meno. No. 3727-F dt. 20-05-2009 and paid out of contingency, will be done, on or after 01-04-2010. Officer/Officers responsible for such engagement will be personally liable for violation of this Order.

- (xiv) The final approval will be given by the ACS/Principal Secretary/Secretary as the case may be, of the concerned Department, after exercising necessary checks & balances & ensuring that any ineligible person does not get the benefits of this order.
- (xv) A proforma statement is hereby annexed for supplying information by the respective appointing authority to the Administrative Department.



In this Department No. 9008-P(P) dated 16.09.2011 it was decided to allow appropriate emoluments, security of tenure and certain terminal benefits to the casual/daily rated/contractual workers subject to fulfilment of conditions therein.

- 2. The matter regarding improvement of monthly remuneration, annual increase, medical facility, leave and others benefits as well as review of the conditions of engagement were under active consideration of the Government for some time past.
- 3. Now, after careful consideration of the matter, the Governor has been pleased to decide to revise the benefits as follows:
- (i) All contractual / casual / daily rated workers shall continue to be in engagement up to the age of 60 years. Engagement of contractual / casual / daily rated worker shall not be terminated except as prescribed in the above referred Memo.
- (ii) Consolidated monthly remuneration of contractual / casual / daily rated workers will be as follows:


