

## Note on W.P. No 55 of 2003

In the matter W.P. (Civil) No.196 of 2001 Hon'ble Supreme Court directed for formulation of scheme of Shelter for Urban Homeless to provide Shelter to the Urban Homeless and Govt. of West Bengal through Women & Child Development and Social Welfare Department formulated the scheme Shelter for Urban Homeless and as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court a survey was conducted to ascertain the number of Urban Homeless. In compliance of the order Shelter for Urban Homeless was conceived in three Municipal Corporations namely Kolkata Municipal Corporation, Howrah Municipal Corporation and Asansol Municipal Corporation and 44 Shelters were functional by Women & Child Development and Social Welfare Department.

The Writ Petition (Civil) No.196 of 2001 and Writ Petition (Civil) No.55 were heard jointly by the Hon'ble Supreme Court subsequently. In compliance of the order dated 26.02.2014 in respect to Writ Petition (C) No.55 of 2003 The Chief Secretary of West Bengal swore before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and submitted act relating to provide Shelter for Urban Homeless on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2014 indicating the status of West Bengal providing Shelter to the poor as a whole, compliance of the order in respect of W.P (Civil) No.196 of 2001 and different Housing Programme being implemented in the State of West Bengal in Urban area including National Urban Livelihood Mission, Rajiv Awas Yojana, Basic Services for Urban Poor, IHSDP, Housing for Urban Poor and Shelters running in Kolkata Municipal Corporation area. The programme National Urban Livelihood Mission was started in the year 2014 and in our State it starts functioning from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2014. In the initial Writ Petition (Civil) No. 55 of 2003 the provision of providing Shelter for Urban Homeless was not impleaded. Subsequent submission by Mr. Prasant Bhusan, Advocate on record on behalf of the petitioner E.R.Kumar, The Hon'ble Supreme Court by their order dated 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 directed the State to provide Shelter for Urban Homeless through the component Shelter for Urban Homeless under National Urban Livelihood Mission also.

The copy of the Affidavit sworn by Shri Sanjay Mitra, IAS, Ex Chief Secretary West Bengal on 26.02.2014 in respect of Writ Petition 55 of 2003 in the matter of E.R. Kumar & Anr. Versus Union of India is annexed hereto and is marked as **Annexure I**

An interim order passed on 11.11.2016 by the Bench Hon'ble Chief Justice T.S. Thakur, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dr. D.Y. Chandrachud and Hon'ble Mr. Justice L. Nageswara Rao is placed as **Annexure II** for kind perusal. By the said order a Committee was constituted with the logistic support of MoHUPA, GoI which was empowered to intervene in any aspect of policy and implementation of Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) including physical verification.

The said Committee held a meeting at UD&MA Deptt on 03.05.2017 and made physical verification of 02(two) shelters in Kolkata Municipal Corporation area. The

minutes of the said meeting is annexed hereto as **Annexure III** and the final report by the committee was submitted before the Hon'ble Apex Court on 01.07.2017 which is marked as **Annexure IV**. Observations as made in the final report of the Committee are complied with as:

The mapping of urban homeless and identification of land in Urban Local Bodies other than KMC have been done,

114 Executive Committee and 47 Shelter Management Committee have been formed in different ULBs.

Agencies managing shelters have been trained in all cases.

Subsequently on the basis of the eMail by Ld. Advocate on Record on 09.08.2017 an affidavit was filed by Director SUDA on behalf of the State on 30.08.2017 which is marked as **Annexure V**.

Another order was passed thereafter by Hon'ble Apex Court which is placed and marked as **Annexure VI**.

In pursuance of the said order an Affidavit was sworn by Director SUDA on 06.11.2017 on behalf of the state which is annexed hereto as **Annexure VII**. In addition thereto a compliance report was submitted by SUDA on 07.11.2017 (Annexed hereto as **Annexure VIII**). Hon'ble Apex Court directed the State on 08.11.2017 to file another Affidavit in the form a reply to the Questionnaire submitted by the Petitioner. (Marked as **Annexure IX**)

Accordingly another Affidavit was sworn by Director SUDA on 23.11.2017 (Marked as **Annexure X**)

Hon'ble Apex Court passed an order on 23.11.2017 in which it was held that the State shall submit a more specific Roadmap and Vision Document before the subsequent date of hearing i.e; on 13.12.2017 (Copy of the Order annexed hereto as **Annexure XI**)

The copy of the Affidavit is annexed hereto as **Annexure XII**.

#### **Observation on the Affidavit Sworn by GoI**

In respect of WP No. 55/2003 the affidavit filed by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Govt. of India before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on the last date of hearing i.e., 13/12/2017 is placed in the file (Marked as **Annexure XIII**) for kind perusal of the higher authority.

Important salient features brought to the kind notice of the apex court are herein under:

Para 7 of the said Affidavit clearly states that all the States will have to keep the funds **earmarked** / allocated for Shelter for Urban Homeless (**SUH**) component, out of to

funds under NULM in a separate Account and furnish details of utilization of funds for SUH component separately along with Report by the Auditor w.e.f. 2018-'19. An Executive Order vide No. 12018(II)/1/2017/ - UPA - II (EFS - 3146332) dated 04/12/2017 has been issued in this regard by MoHUA. The State has utilized 98% of the fund allocated for entire NULM and West Bengal holds the No. 1 position in ranking of States done by MoHUA. Status of utilisation of fund is annexed herewith at the **Annexure - XIII**

MoHUPA has issued another Order vide No. 12018(II)/1/2017 - UPA - II (EFS - 3146332) that conduct of a **Special Audit** of NULM funds has to be made for the year 2015 - 16.

Annual Audit of each Financial Year starting from 2014-15 was conducted by the Chartered Firm as per guideline of MoHUPA till 2016-17 and the report has been submitted to Govt. of India accepting which the fund has been released. In consideration of the same, construction & progress of SUH was never affected in the State for want of fund.

Govt. of India in the affidavit proposed to constitute a committee headed by a retired officer at level equivalent to secretary to GOI, respective Principal Secretary, UD and with the provision of co-opting an official dealing with issue of urban homeless. This may be complied with.

The Hon'ble Court passed an order desiring the presence of Chief Secretary, West Bengal (Annexed hereto as **Annexure XIV**).

The next date of hearing is on 10/01/2018.

**AREA OF INTERVENTION OF CHIEF SECRETARY****a. FRESH SURVEY BY 3<sup>RD</sup> PARTY:**

Out of the 104967 (as per census 2011) homeless populations approximately 5450 homeless population will be covered under the scheme Shelter for Urban Homeless under NULM, 1856 homeless population is already covered under the shelters run by Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare. These are being made NULM compliant, around 20000 homeless populations has been covered under the State Scheme Housing for Urban Poor, another 20000 will be covered under the same scheme.

It is pertinent here to mention that in 2014 a Night Survey was conducted by Change Management Unit (CMU) under Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department and 6468 (excluding Kolkata Municipal Corporation Area) homeless people were identified in the State.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has so far taken cognizance of a figure of 104967 (one lakh four thousand nine hundred sixty seven) as a sacrosanct homeless population as per census 2011 data. According to that the State is supposed to build 1050 shelters. Indeed it is a difficult task. In this regard the contents of the letter No. M-13/23/2017/UPA/Section-MHUPA (EFS-9026963) dated 15.11.2017 of Deputy Secretary, MoHUPA, GOI is brought to the kind notice. It is stated therein that the Committee formed under the aegis of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed the States visited by them to conduct a survey for obtaining the number of Urban Homeless by involving a 3<sup>rd</sup> Party as it has been observed by the Hon'ble Court that the survey is conducted by States on their own is not Authentic as different figures have been given at different stages. In view thereof Govt. of India has requested for a 3<sup>rd</sup> party systematic survey for identification of Urban Homeless at the ULBs to be carried out on an urgent basis and the same may be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2018 so that actual number of identification of urban homeless figure in the State can be validated.

**Decision of the highest echelon of the State Govt. is required in this regard.**

**b. INTERVENTION of CHIEF SECY REGARDING KOLKATA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION:**

Kolkata Municipal Corporation has informed the following.

**Census report, 2011** states that there were approximately **69798 urban homeless** population in Kolkata. But as per order and directives of Hon'ble Supreme of India in the matter of **W.P. No. 196(C) of 2001** and as per consequent decision taken in the **meeting** held in the office of the **Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal on 31.01.2011**, a rapid assessment **survey** was held in 141 wards of Kolkata Municipal Corporation from **04.02.2011** to map the homeless population, their concentration points in Kolkata, their composition and reason for migration. The rapid assessment survey, undertaken in public-private mode was **conducted** in Kolkata **by the Calcutta Samaritans, a civil society organization** having proven background of working on this social issue and funding

support came from the State Government (the DFID aided Kolkata Urban Services for Poor project under Department of Municipal Affairs. **Total 37468 homeless people were identified in this survey. That means if we go by the Census 2011 report then 750 shelters are required to be established and if the figure of the Survey done by Calcutta Samaritans then 375 Shelters are to be established,** KMC have been intimated time to time regarding construction of SUH vide different no. dated 26.05.2017, 23.08.2017, 13.11.2017. In the meeting dated 16.11.2017 and 23.11.2017 the matter were discussed in details for the compliance of creation of SUH.

**Steps taken by Kolkata Municipal Corporation so far:-**

**Identification of Land for construction of shelters:** It has been informed by Kolkata Municipal Corporation that they have taken the following steps as stated below.

- (i) The following land and space have been identified by KMC :
  - (a) 15 Cotthas of land at trenching ground in Ward no. 133.
  - (b) 15 Cotthas of land at 33A, B & C Canal South Road at Ward no. 57.
  - (c) 5 Cotthas of land at 29 Birpara road at Ward no. 2
  - (d) Additional floor, measuring about 18000 sq. ft. on the existing premises at 13 Raja Manindra Road at Ward No.133.
  - (e) Some other plots of land as mentioned below possessed by other parastatals under Govt. of West Bengal has also been identified :
    - i. Premises at Tilak Nagar at Ward No.95 under possession of KMDA
    - ii. Premises at Gandhi Colony at Ward No.95 under possession of KMDA
    - iii. Premises near Lady Dafferin Hospital at Ward No.49 under possession of erstwhile KIT
    - iv. Premises at 34 Surya Sen Street at Ward No.49 under possession of KIT
    - v. Vacant space near Park Street Flyover and log gate area under possession of HRBC
  - (f) Kolkata MC intended to identified some other land which is under Railways Ministry at Chitpur, Majherhat, Ballygunge, Sealdah & Narkeldanga which will be inspected and a report will be submitted by the KMC.
  - (g) KMC mentioned that they need atleast 280 Bighas of land for accommodating all the urban homeless as appeared in Census 2011 to comply with the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.

It may be stated that the process of preparation of DPR and other formalities is expected to be completed by March, 2018 and the construction of those shelters is expected to be completed by June, 2019.

**Arrangement of Shelters on Rental Basis**

It has been informed by Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) that initiatives are also being taken by them for arrangement of shelters on rental basis. Advertisement is being

made in the leading newspapers in order to invite owners allowing Kolkata Municipal Corporation to use their buildings as shelters on rental basis.

(i) It has been informed by Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) that they have also taken initiatives for identification of unutilized/dilapidated buildings owned by private owners or other Departments to utilize the same as Shelters for Urban Homeless on rental basis. An extensive effort is being exerted to identify such buildings. This process is expected to be completed within June, 2018. The process of renovation of these buildings will take further 3 to 4 months and the shelter may be ready by October, 2018.

(ii) Women & Child Development and Social Welfare Department have been requested for making NULM compliant of shelter for homeless being run by the department vide different no. dated 15.02.2017, 28.04.2017, 13.11.2017 and 06.12.2017.

*Therefore it humbly submitted that Co- ordination between different authorities with KMC can be ensured smoothly if intervention of the highest level of the State Government is made.*

C. There are 41 Shelters run by the Women & Child Development and Social Welfare Department accommodating nearly 1856 homeless people (Kolkata – 35, Asansol – 3, Howrah – 3)

**Intervention of the highest level is required: .**

- To ascertain the number of urban homeless the survey is required to be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 and KMC will complete their survey engaging independent survey agency as directed by Hon'ble Supreme Court and intimated by GOI and submit the specific plan for coverage of whole homeless population by constructing new shelters, arranging rental buildings and or utilising building or homes of Government or private. For sanctioned and approved schemes of SUH, KMC will complete the SUH.
- To make these 41 shelters of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare Dept to be NULM Compliant under SUH on the basis of providing Operational and Maintenance cost of running shelters from NULM and refurbishment cost of existing shelter buildings from NULM fund.
- Since inception Rs.186.94 crore has been received for NULM including central share of Rs. 130.57 crore out of which Rs. 183.85 has been utilised. Demand has been placed before GOI to release Rs.22.88 crore and Rs.72.15 as committed liabilities of previous year. No fund has been release in this regard so far.

**Sub: Report of Joint field visit for convergence of existing shelters run by the Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare with DAY-NULM**

As per approval on note sheet page on 07 the undersigned has visited the shelters run by the Women & Child Development & Social Welfare Department along with the three Welfare Officer of the concerned Department within the Kolkata Municipal Corporation area from 21.06.2018 & 22.06.2018 and 27.06.2018 to 29.06.2018. Detailed information has been collected individual shelter wise and consolidated report is prepared accordingly. Mainly emphasised on provision of convergence under NULM and review the basic facilities of shelters as per NULM guidelines. Based on these, possibilities are find out and mentioned in the report herewith. It appears that most of the shelters are functional in rented building and most of these are in congested area. Bathing and toilets facilities are not adequate as per NULM guidelines in these shelters and also the space in shelter per person is less than 50 sqft. The undersigned visited all the shelter during the day time (11 am to 6 pm) and also collected the photographs of the shelters. It may be noted that one shelter unit at Oxytwon, Behala area was closed during the visit and no one was spotted in the shelter. It may be further noted that some of the shelters are functional in Kolkata Corporation Building. In these cases renovation or repair work may be done. It may be mentioned that one shelter unit is functional in KMDA land near Ultadanga Railway Station and sufficient space is available for construction of new shelter unit under NULM.

As suggested in the meeting at the Chamber of Principle Secretary UD & MA Dept. now the report 'X' regarding the functional shelters under WC & SW Dept. is placed herewith for kind consideration and further action.

From the Pud, it appears that U/S, MoHUA, Govt of India mentioned in his letter in reference to the vide letter no. Psecy/UD & MA/2019/165 dated: 17.04.2019 that **in case of unavailability of officers of the level of Secretary (Retd) to GOI, Govt. of West Bengal may suggest the name of officer retired at the level of Secretary to the respective state to serve as Chairman of the Committee** so that the name could be suggested to Hon'ble Supreme Court during the forthcoming hearing.

Under Secretary also requested to **continue the meeting of SLSMC for monitoring of shelters under the chairmanship of Secretary (UD)/ Principal Secretary (UD), who is also a member of SLSMC, until the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court on your request.**

In this regard it may be mentioned that a letter vide memo no. Psecy/UD & MA/2019/165 dated: 17.04.2019 has been sent from Principal Secretary, UD & MA Dept. to the Joint Secretary & Mission Director (DAY-NULM), Govt. of India, MoHUA regarding the Chairman of SLSMC. It has been mentioned in this letter that we don't right now have any officer of similar rank to act as Chairman of SLSMC. Then, a request for guidance about selection of a Chairman for SLMC has been solicited in this letter. (Copy of this letter placed in the C.P. side mark as 'X')

In this context now the matter may be placed before the Principal Secretary, UD & MA Department for consideration & further process.
