Street vending constitutes an important segment in the informal economy of the cities. It is an integral part of urban growth and occupies an important place in the urban supply chain by providing for inexpensive and convenient access to goods and services and ensuring significant job creation in the non-formal sector. The important role played by urban street vendors has been given due recognition in the NULM programme in which 'Support to Urban Street Vendors' (SUSV) is an important component. This component seeks to address the vulnerabilities faced by the urban street vendors by facilitating their access to suitable vending zones, to institutional credit, to improved skills and social security. A copy of the operational guidelines on 'Support to Urban Street Vendors (SUSV)' component of NULM is placed in the file for ready reference. (Flagged-Y)

For streamlining the activities of the street vendors, a Guideline for regulating street vending in the urban areas' was issued by MA Deptt. under its memo 237(128)/M.A/O/C-4/1A-10/2011 of 18th June, 2014 (flagged-Z in the file) covering various important issues relating to street vendors such as constitution of Municipal Vending Committee; Registration of Street Vendors etc. The progress made by the ULBs in this regard is however not known to us.

Kolkata Municipal Corporation, in the meanwhile, has informed that they have taken a series of initiatives for rehabilitation and regulation of street vendors. Some such initiatives, as informed by KMC include constitution of vending committee, process of identification and registration of street vendors, providing social security to street vendors, opening of a dedicated website for the vendors under URL www.kmchawkerbandhu.com etc. The initiatives taken by KMC have widely been publicized by them.

For accomplishment of the tasks ahead of them, KMC has placed a demand for Rs.5.00 cr. in their memo Com/Con/105/2015-16 dated 2.6.2015. Considering the nature of tasks proposed to be done by KMC and the fact that a substantial amount of fund is lying unutilized under NULM, Rs.5.00 cr. may be approved for release to KMC.

As per quarry of Principal Secretary, UD & MA Dept. on pre page notes it may be mentioned that, Support to Urban Street Vendor is one of the important component under DAY-NULM. The objective of the component is to address the vulnerabilities of the urban street vendors through a multi-pronged approach. This includes:

- (i) Survey of street vendors and issue of Identity Cards
- (ii) Development of city street vending plans
- (iii) Infrastructure development of vending zones in the city
- (iv) Training and Skill Development
- (v) Financial Inclusion
- (vi) Access to credit
- (vii) Linkages to social security schemes

It may be further mentioned that, as per guidelines of SUSV clause 3.1 the State Government shall have overall responsibility for:

- (i) Providing overall direction..
- (ii) Establishing mechanisms for sanction of project proposals.
- (iii) Establishing mechanisms for monitoring and supervision of implementation.
- (iv) Establishing mechanisms for progress reporting.

The State Urban Livelihoods Mission (SULM) will be the nodal agency responsible for overall implementation of the component. At the city level, the responsibility for implementation will rest with the Urban Local Body (ULB).

Pre-page note has been given on receipt of a letter from Shri Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary and Mission Director (DAY-NULM), Government of India, wherein he has requested to identify two ULBs (preferably Million Plus Cities), which can be developed as Model ULB under Support to Urban Street Vendors (SUSV), a component of NULM.

We have already published Street Vending Rules, 2018 for our State as well as circulated a draft Model Scheme to all the ULBs.

We are yet to get any feedback from any Municipality/Corporation in regard to constitution of Town Vending Committee as well as opinion in regard to the Model Scheme.

In order to guide the ULBs, the letter in the proposed manner may be sent to all the ULBs from the end of Director, SUDA.

Secondly, two or four/five ULBs may be identified with due approval of Hon'ble MIC, so that these ULBs can be developed as Model ULBs, where implementation of Street Vending Rules and adoption of scheme can be done on pilot basis with partial fund support of NULM.





Sub: Request for release of fund to the tune of Rs. 50 Lakh facilitating Kolkata Municipal Corporation to run the urban street vendor scheme under NULM.

It may be mentioned that, as per State West Bengal Urban Street Vendors Rules, 2018 Kolkata Municipal Corporation has already constituted on 30.10.2018. It is pertinent to mention that under DAY-NULM guidelines a component i.e. Support to Urban Street Vendors also covered under the Street Vendors Act, 2014. As per this component different benefits i.e. social benefits, financial assistance, skill training may be provided to the urban street vendors.

Now this office has received a letter vide no. **335/SW&UPA/2018-19** dated: **11.12.2018** from Kolkata Municipal Corporation regarding release of fund to the tune of Rs. 50 Lakh to run the 'Support to Urban Street Vendor, scheme (copy enclosed as 'X').

In this connection it may be recalled that, this office had already released an amount of Rs. 2.50 Crore in favour KMC on **27.08.2015** for IEC activities, digitalization of applications, providing model stalls/kiosks, issuance of registration certificate to the identified hawkers etc. As per report available at this office till now no such activities have been taken by KMC on aforesaid areas. As per the aforementioned letter KMC has already remitted an amount of Rs. 2,41,83,202.00 to the finance Department, Govt. of West Bengal on 03.01.2018 out of sanctioned amount Rs. 25,50,00,000.00. It may be noted that this office has not received the Utilization Certificate of this balance fund which have utilized by KMC.

It may be further mentioned that as the Street Vendors scheme is not finalized and decision regarding for street vendors survey is yet to be approved by UD & MA Dept. therefore fund provision for the ULBs in this regard is not finalized.

Under these circumstances a letter may be sent to KMC for submission of UC for this utilized fund out of Rs. 2.50 Crore & for details of the activities under this scheme. After finalization of the Street Vendors Scheme & necessary approval for survey, requisite fund may be released in favour of KMC for the 'Support to Urban Street Vendors Scheme.

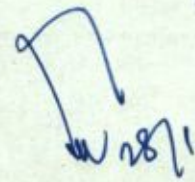
