

Sub: Arrangement of one day workshop on GIS based survey for Urban Homeless population in 124 ULBs of West Bengal

It may be mentioned that as per order of Hon'ble Supreme Court a third party GIS based survey for urban homeless population will be conducted in 125 ULBs of West Bengal. After completion of the tender process I Win Advisory Services Ltd. is selected as L1 bidder to conduct this survey in 124 ULB

Now for field implementation and resource mapping of this survey a workshop may be arranged with the 124 ULBs for necessary information and their participation in the survey. In this connection a field implementation plan is prepared (copy enclosed). As per terms & conditions and scope of works as stated in the tender notice this workshop will be conducted. Role of the State Mission Management Unit, City Mission Management Unit & surveying agency will be briefed in this workshop. Also the guidelines of the survey as per guidelines of SUH will be distributed to 124 ULBs.

This workshop may be arranged in two days (10.04.2018 and 11.04.2018) for two different phases of ULBs (i.e. 1 st phase 57 ULBs excluding KMC and 2 nd phase 67 ULBs)

In this regard all State Mission Managers may attend the workshop for the mentoring as mentioned in the field implementation plan. Concerned official from the surveying agency will be present in this workshop for discussion on survey and resource mapping related issues. If time permits we may also conduct an internal meeting with the staff of CMMUs and other ULBs.

In this connection to facilitate the entire programme logistics support, food and training kits may be arranged and letters to the concerned ULBs may be sent for information and active participation in this workshop.

Sub: Release of fund for payment towards the agency conducted GIS Based third party survey in 124 ULBs in West Bengal.

It may be mentioned that as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, and as per order vide no. M-13/23/2017- MoHUA (UPA division) dated: 15.11.2017 Ministry of Urban & Housing Affairs requested to all States/UT to submit a report of third party systematic survey for identification of urban homeless in ULB level. In this context it may be mentioned that an agency was engaged through e-Tender (RFP) vide no. SUDA-285/2017/1381 dated: 29.01.2018 to conduct GIS Based survey for identification of urban homeless in 124 ULBs (excluding Kolkata). A work Order vide no. SUDA-285/2017/1809 dated: 29.03.2018 was issued in favour of I WIN ADVISORY AGENCY (copy enclosed). Now the surveying agency .i.e. I Win Advisory Services Ltd. completed the field survey in all 124 ULBs in the state and submitted the final report of filed survey to this office (copy enclosed as X). This agency conducted the field survey as per terms and condition of e-Tender of said work. As per work order this work was delivered to the agency on an amount of Rs. 24,11,920.00 Now this agency has submitted a bill of amounting Rs. 964768.00 (including GST) (40 % of work order value). (Copy enclosed)

It may be recalled that a tentative budget of **Rs.** 48.84 Lakh was prepared for conduct the GIS based and this budget was approved by the UD & MA Dept. After completion of GIS Based third party survey it appears that an amount of Rs.18.95 Lakh is required for homeless survey in KMC area and **Rs.** 24.12 Lakh for homeless survey in 124 ULBs. It may be mentioned that as per operational guidelines of SUH Clause 6.2 third party systematic survey is mandatory for identification for homeless persons. 

In this connection it may be mentioned that already 40% of total work order value has been released to the agency. Now the agency claimed for rest 40 % & 20 % of work order value.

Under these circumstances now we may release further 40% only towards the concerned agency and further 20 % will be released after finalization of soft copy GIS map of ULBs and other deliverable works as per NIT.
