

## **Overall Municipal Vision**

Baduria Municipality in deciding on its vision for the future draws inspiration from the vision for the Eleventh Five Year Plan of the north 24 Parganas District, which provides the broad frame.

#### Vision for the Eleventh Five-Year Plan of District North 24 Parganas:

In the process of the Fourteenth Five Year Plan, the District Planning Committee emphasizes upon a strategic vision towards a well-set target for different basic indicators of development. 24 Pgs, being one of the most densely populated districts in West Bengal has to face problems in reaching goals so far as planned development is concerned. A realistic vision for decentralized planning ensuring participation of people in the planning process has been adopted. The vision would be primarily articulate in terms of goals and outcomes and would address basically, three aspects of development in the productive sector. These sectors are:

- a. Human Development
- b. Infrastructure Development
- c. Productive Sector Development

Planned development in the said three sectors will bring total development for the district as a whole. For this purpose target has to be set in each sector for the plan period and achievement of target through well-directed planned process has to be ensured. Some important basic sectors are to be taken on priority basis. These are:

- o Health
- o Education
- o Women and Child Welfare
- o Social justice and Social Security
- Safe drinking Water Supply
- o Employment
- o Development of Rural Roads
- o Electricity
- o Housing for the poor

The District Planning Committee also envisages importance in implementation of the incomplete projects of the Tenth Five Year Plan in the priority sectors.

In the health sector priority has been accorded on Primary Health Care, Improvement of Service Delivery Systems, 100% coverage in Sanitation Programme, Convergence of activities of Health, ICDS and Social Welfare, Strengthening of Sub Centres and Primary Health Centres, 100% Institutional Delivery, Ensuring nutritional support to mothers and children, 100% coverage for pre-natal and post-natal check up, 100% coverage of birth, death and marriage registration and Ensuring supply of emergency medicines in all Health Institutions among few more. Associated with the health sector is the emphasis on the sector dealing with Women and Child issues like ICDS Centre for each 1000 population, Enrolment of all the children in Primary Schools, SSKs, or ICDS Centres, Nutritional support for all the children, Improvement of female literacy rate to 80% by 2012, Economic empowerment for women through formation of SHG, Generation of awareness among women of disadvantageous groups to bring down gender discrimination, Awareness generation against dowry system among many more.

The education sector emphasis has been accorded on Achieving literacy rate from 66.2% to 90% by 2012, Reduction of gender gap in literacy to achieve 85% female literacy by 2012, Enrolment of 100% children in schools, Attaining 'no drop out' by 2012, Drinking water and toilets in all schools, SSKs an MSKs, At least 4 classrooms in all Primary Schools, Building

for all SSKs and MSKs, At least one Girls High School in each Gram Panchayets, Provision of Special Schools and Linkage of all the learners of Continuing Education Centres with SHGs.

Livelihood issues have addresses under the section on Social Justice and Social Security. Special emphasis has been given on development of Tribal and minority Communities, 100 days work for all eligible workers, Eradication of child labour from hazardous professions by 2012, Ensuring minimum wages for all workers, Special emphasis on handicrafts, food processing, horticulture etc. and linking of linking of weaker sections particularly Special attention to the physically challenged persons, Strengthening social security services like different pensions and other services.

Employment generation issues would include Special attention on Cottage & Small Industries, Promotion of local handicrafts, Development of handloom and power loom industries Encouragement in self-employment and income generating group activities, Setting up marketing complexes and market outlets, Special emphasis on micro credit, group loans, short and midterm loans, Setting up of Handloom Export Mart at Municipal Market Complex, Food Park and facilitating setting up of some medium industries.

On the infrastructural front Roads, drinking water, housing for the Poor have been given special emphasis. Development of the Roads Sector would include maintenance of existing blacktop roads, widening of narrow roads, construction of black top roads and opening of transportation routes etc Housing Development would include Low cost Rural Housing Scheme for the poor, Improvement of slum areas with sanitation arrangements among others.

All the above provided information is published by the Municipality in their books, "Baduriar Sekal Ekal"-documents of the ancient history of Baduria.

The socio-cultural activities of this region are closely interlinked with traditional way and norms. That's why a community hall was established at the premises of the Municipality for performing various cultural and social activities.

#### Historical Background: -

Baduria is one of the oldest Municipalities situated at the bank of river Ichhamoti. It was established in the year 1869 comprising of four detached land, P.O. & P.S. Baduria in Basirhat Sub-division, Dist. North 24 Parganas, West Bengal, India. It is 60 K.M. away from Kolkata. The total area of the Municipality is 22.43 sq. K.M.

The generation of Raja Protapaditya was known as "Raja", from Jessore (now in Bangladesh) had been living at Khorgachhi at time of Mughal period under this Municipality. Thousand

years ago during the time of 2<sup>nd</sup> Chandragupta (Gupta Yuga), the generation of Raja Chandraketu was also living at *Andharmanik*. During the British period a good number of Jaminder used to live here.

This Municipality is enriched with so many historical places of interest like, "Shri Shri Anandamoyee Kali Mandir", along with "Twelve Shiva Mandir", which was established in the year 1219. "Ek Mandir", "Rowsan Bibi Darga" which was established more than six thousand year ago. There are 4 (four) "Shiva Mandir", A gate of one Rupee at Arbelia. Darga of Sahachand, A mandir of "Brindaban Chandra", at Baduria which was established at the time of Maharaja Krishna Chandra Dev. There was a Shivabati at Rudhrapur established in the year 620 B.S.

Out of those historical places there was a Sanskrit School at Purnia & Andharmanik under the Municipal area. Punra (School of Sanskrit) was known as "Chotto nabadwip" at the time of Shri Shri Chaitanya Dev. Many students from different places used to came here to learn "Sanskrit". Right now there are 4(four) Co-educational Higher Secondary Schools, 2(two) Junior Basic Schools, 40(forty) Primary Schools and Twenty Sishu Siksha Schools and 16(sixteen) Sarba Shiksha Kendra. There is no college in the surrounding area even now.



#### **National Poverty Alleviation Programmes and PMAY**

#### Slum: the focus Area

Under section-3 of the Slum Area Improvement and Clearance Act, 1956, slums have been defined as mainly those residential areas where dwellings are in any respect unfit for human habitation by reasons of dilapidation, overcrowding, faulty arrangements and designs of such buildings, narrowness and faulty arrangement of streets, lack ventilation, light or sanitation facilities or any combination of these factors which are detrimental to safety, health and morals. Thus, conceptually slums are compact overcrowded residential areas (and not isolated or scattered dwellings) unfit for habitation due to lack of one or more of the basic infrastructure like drinking water, sanitation, electricity, sewerage, streets etc.

It is in this background that in the 2001 Census, an innovative attempt was made to collect demographic data slum areas across the country.

As per 2001 population census, the slum population is estimated to be 61.8 million, out of a total urban population of 285.35 million people reside in urban areas.

The analysis of the data in this report provided an overview of the population characteristics of slums and squatter settlements and is expected to serve as a benchmark for pragmatic and realistic town planning while dealing with the issue of slums and slum dwellers.

#### Background

- Urbanization is fast becoming the defining process in shaping the course of social transformation & ensuing development concerns in India. About 377 million persons or about 31% of India's population of 1.21 billion lived in urban areas in 2011, spread over 5161 towns.
  - As per Report on Indian Urban Infrastructure and Services (NIUA) Report\_, the urban population is likely to grow to about 600 million by 2031. About one-fourth (24%) of the urban population of India is poor i.e. their expenditure on consumption goods is less than the poverty line benchmark. The benefits of urbanization have eluded this burgeoning 67 million urban poor population, most of who live in slums. An analysis of population growth trends between 1991 and 2001 shows that while India grew at an average annual growth rate of 2%, urban India grew at 3% mega cities at 4% and slum populations rose by 5%. This rapid and unplanned urbanization and simultaneous growth of urban population in the limited living spaces has a visible impact on the quality of life of the slum dwellers of the city.
- 2. It is increasing clear that sustainable growth can only take place when it is inclusive and when the entire population including the poor and marginalized need to have at the least access to descent shelter, basic amenities, livelihoods and a voice in governance. Keeping this in mind the Government of India and the various State Governments have been taking up several schemes on partnership mode.

# National Missions for Slum Development and Poverty Reduction

- i. The Government of India is committed to creating as lumfree India as part of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission(JNNURM) submission on Basic Services for the Urban Poor(BSUP). More recently it has also launched the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) for providing Housing for All (HFA) by 2022 when the Nation Complete 75 years of its independence.
- ii. <u>Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM</u>): JNNURM is are form-linked urban development and slum upgrading program. Under JNNURM, the Government of India has been providing central assistance to 65 metro and large cities to invest in infrastructure improvements with governance reforms under submission on Urban Development.
- iii. Swarna Jayanti Shahri Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY): SJSRY is a centrally sponsored program and it mainly emphasizes on the poverty reduction through employment generation. Main target groups of the program are: Urban poor, Women, SC/ST, Disabled etc.

#### iv. National Slum Development Program (NSDP):

NSDP is a centrally assisted slum development program. NSDP is mainly for improvement in the environment in the slums as a broader objective through provision of infrastructure facilities and shelter for improving living conditions in the slums.

- v. Valmiki Ambedkar Awas Yojana (VAMBAY): VAMBAY is a central Government scheme to provide housing to the poor. Under VAMBAY scheme, an amount of Rs.50,000 is extended to a beneficiary in a city with more than 10 lacs population while in the cities having population less than 10 lacs. Each beneficiary gets Rs.40,000/- fifty percent of the amount is central government grant while the rest could be taken as loan from HUDCO/ other nationalized banks/state government/urban local bodies.
- vi. <u>Integrated housing and slum development program (IHSDP):</u>IHSDP was under Jawaharlal Nehru Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) beginning from the year 2006-2008.

#### The major objectives for the IHSDP program are:-

Focussed attention to integrated development of basic services to the poor. The basic
services include security of tenure at affordable price, improving housing, water supply and
sanitation.

Secure effective link ages between asset creation and asset management so that the basic
services to the urban poor created in the cities, are not only maintained efficiently but also
become self-sustaining over time.

# HFAPoA and Prodhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Housing for All)

To give pucca house for every family is currently on the global agenda. One of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) is to 'achieve significant improvement in the lives of slum dwellers, by 2022. Similar goals are set forth by Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana within year 2022, to create pucca house for every family.

ULB undertake a demand survey through suitable means for assessing the actual demand of housing. While validating demand survey, Cities consider possible temporary migration from rural areas to the city just to take advantage of housing scheme and exclude such migrants from list of beneficiaries. On the basis of demand survey and other available data, cities prepare Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA). HFAPoA contain the demand of housing by eligible beneficiaries in the city along with the interventions selected out of four verticals. The information regarding beneficiaries is collected by ULB in suitable. While preparing HFAPoA, ULB and Implementing Agencies also consider the affordable housing stock already available in the city as Census data suggests that large number of houses are vacant.

Bank account number and Aadhaar number/Voter ID card/any other unique identification details of intended beneficiaries or a certificate of house ownership from Revenue Authority of beneficiary's native district integrate in the data base of HFAPoA for avoiding duplication of benefit to one individual family. Beneficiaries is validated by ULBs thereby ensuring their eligibility at the time of preparation of the projects and approval of projects.

On the basis of HFAPoA, States/Cities subsequently prepare the Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) dividing the task upto 2022 in view of the availability of resources and priority. For larger cities, HFAPoA and AIPs is prepared at sub-city (ward/zone etc.) level with the approval of concerned State/UT Government. The result of demand survey, draft HFAPoA and draft AIP is discussed with the local representatives including MLAs and MPs of that area so that their views are adequately factored in while finalising the plans and beneficiary list.

Cities which have already prepared Slum Free City Plan of Action (SFCPoA) or any other housing plan with data on housing, utilise the existing plan and data for preparing "Housing for All Plan of Action" (HFAPoA). Houses constructed under various schemes should be accounted for while preparing HFAPoA

Urban Population Living in Slums and the Indian Scenario (source: UN-HABITAT)

The preparation of HFAPoA broadly involve Slum Development/Rehabilitation Plans

#### based on

- a. Survey of all slums notified and non-notified;
- Mapping of slums using the state-of-art technology;
- c. Integration of geo-spatial and socio-economic data; and
- Identification of development model proposed for each slum.
  - Base maps to an appropriate scale would be a pre-requisite for the preparation of Slum Development Plan/Slum-free City Plan. States/UTs may need to proceed in the following steps for the preparation of Slumfree City Plans.
  - Securing CARTOSAT II/latest satellite images from NRSC/ISRO and preparation of base maps for the whole city and its fringes using the images;
  - Identification and inventory of all slum clusters of all descriptions in the urban agglomeration with the help of satellite image and other available data;
  - Inventory of all possible vacant lands in each zone of the urban agglomeration that could be
    - used for slum development/ rehabilitation development purposes;
  - 5. Development of Slum Map of every slum within the city and its fringes using GIS with CARTOSAT II images, ground level spatial data collected through total station survey, collating spatial information with respect to plot boundaries, network of basic infrastructure like roads, sewerage, storm drainage and water lines, etc and superimposing this on the satellite image and importing them into GIS platform as the first step towards the preparation of Slum Development Plans and Slum Free City Plan.
  - 6. This may be undertaken with the help of technical partners of NRSC/ISRO/other technical institutions.
  - Identification and engagement of Lead NGO/CBO to guide and anchor community mobilization for the purpose of slum survey, (May be more than one NGO/CBO in different slum zones) of the city. These

Lead NGOs/CBOs should also be associated in slum survey operations and dialogues for preparation of slum level development plans;

- 8. Conduct of Slum Survey based on the detailed formats (with or without changes) prepared by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation with the help of National Buildings Organization (NBO) after due training of trainers, training of survey personnel /canvassers and canvassing. It would be helpful for community mobilization to pick as many canvassers from the sourced slum or nearby slum pockets;
- Collection of bio-metric identification data of slum dwellers based on the above survey (subject to guidelines issued by Unique Identity Authority of India (UIDAI));
- 10. Entry of data from Slum Surveys in the web-enabled MIS application (to be provided by Ministry of HUPA), compilation and collation of data, preparation of Slum-wise, City and State Slum Survey Database and Baseline Reports. The MIS will assist in developing a robust Slum and Slum Households Information System. (Guidelines and software for development of the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);
- 11. Integration of Slum MIS with GIS Maps to enable the preparation of GIS-enabled

Slum Information System that is to be used for the preparation of meaningful Slum

Development Plans and Slum-free City Plan using a city-wide/zone-based

approach.(Guidelines and software for development of GIS platform and its

integration with the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

### Introduction to Prodhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY)

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), a path breaking scheme for the slum dwellers and urban poor envisages a 'Pucca house to every family' through encouraging States to tackle the problem of slums in a holistic manner. It calls for a multi-pronged approach focusing on:

□ Bringing existing slums within the formal system and enabling

them to avail of the same level of basic amenities as the rest of the town. ☐ Redressing the failures of the formal system that lie behind the creation of slums. ☐ Tackling the shortages of urban land and housing that keep shelter out of reach of the urban poor and force them to resort to extra-legal solutions in a bid to retain their sources of livelihood and employment. ☐ Enactment of a set of reforms at the state and city level related to inclusive planning, regulation and financing, which would ensure that adequate fresh housing stock and services get created on an ongoing basis to address both current and future needs of cities. An integrated approach covering shelter, services and livelihoods for poor slum communities.

# The duration of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana [PMAY] 2015 TO 2022

#### Eligible Components of the PMAY:

# Allotment of Houses

Allotment of dwelling units will be in the name of the female member of the . Alternatively, it can be allotted in the name of husband and wife jointly. Ownership of land required for every Beneficiary.

A EWS beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife and unmarried children. The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house (an all weather dwelling unit) either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission.

EWS households are defined as households having an annual income up to Rs.3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakhs). States/UTs shall have the flexibility to redefine the annual income criteria as per local conditions in consultation with the Centre.

# Following infrastructure will be considered for support under PMAY:

- 1. Water connection
- 2. Toilet facilities
- 3. 24 x 7 Electric facilities
- 4. Roads

This development project models will give benefits in the city. One of the key objectives of developing the Projects is to incentivize innovation and encourage new approaches and solutions that can demonstrably improve the quality and quantity of shelter and services for the poor.

#### Vision

The mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through following programme verticals:

- Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource
- Promotion of Affordable Housing for weaker section through credit linked subsidy
- Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors
- Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction

#### **Objectives**

- Integrated development of all existing slums, notified or non-notified, i.e., development of infrastructure and housing in the slums/rehabilitation colonies for the slum dwellers/urban poor, including rental housing.

- ▶ The Creation of affordable housing stock, including rental housing with

the provision of civic infrastructure and services, on ownership.

► Encouraging Public Private Partnership by having pay and use toilets and

educate the slum dwellers for keeping the environment clean and hygienic

#### State PMAY Mission Director

The Nodal Ministry and National Mission Directorate is Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India.

The Nodal Department for West Bengal is Municipal Affairs Dept. (M.A. Department), Government of West Bengal. The state level Nodal Agency is State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) under M.A. Department. State Urban Development Agency was set up in 1991 with a view to ensuring proper implementation and monitoring of the centrally assisted programmes for generating employment opportunities and alleviation of poverty throughout the State. SUDA is a Society registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961.

#### **Funding Pattern of PMAY**

- Central share 1.5 LAKHS of total cost of dwelling unit
- Beneficiary share 0.25 LAKHS of total cost of dwelling unit
- State share rest of total cost of dwelling unit
- State share for infrastructure to be minimum 5%
- ULB share for infrastructure to be minimum 5%
- Cost of infrastructure 10 % of sum total cost of dwelling unit

  - approval of State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee
- Innovative projects to be considered for sanction even in the preparatory stage.

Financial Division of the Ministry. Central share would be released in three installment of 40%,40% and 20% each.
