

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Preface

To keep pace with the honest approach of our honorable Prime Minister and the Chief Minister as well for providing houses to the deserving beneficiaries, by and large we have smoothly crossed two years where in a total no. Introductory Note by Chairperson

Though the Central and the State Government invoked several social welfare and social security schemes for the benefit of the down trodden people of the society. One of the major and may be termed as prime welfare ie 'Housing For All' was not given priority. Houses of the poor people are constructed under few Awas Yojana in various nomenclature but that was very negligible in comparison to actual need. As a result it has been felt to provide houses to each and every deserving people of our country living in both the slum and non slum areas under 4 verticals. Honourable Prime Minister has expressed his desire that in the 75 years of our country's independence there should not be any families without houses of their own.

Naturally the present scheme Housing For All under PRAY has appeared as an golden opportunity before those BPL/ EWS/LIG families who actually deserve to be provided with a house by 2022.

We the elected representatives are duty bound for proper implementation of the scheme as has been laid down in the guide line issued by the Govt.

Town Feature

History: -

Despite having no important historical background of Cooper's Camp, this town which has grown up with mere refugees, has a history of creation and development. In 1942 during the 2nd world war military camps had been developed in Cooper's Camp to supply military food and so to pack up the food storage, railways, roads and drainage systems had also been arranged directly. In the riots of 1946 in Noakhali and in the riots of 1950 in Barishal many peoples lost their lives and after wards (in the next session) Cooper's Camp became the shed and shelter for those people who fled from another side of border. Thousands of people streamed into this camp.

Earlier Cooper's Camp was transit camp. In those early days almost 1.5 lakhs people lived here. From this very place refugees had been transmitted to the various camps in different regions of West Bengal. As for the Govt. relief there were merely some dry dole, cash dole, tents, godowns and bamboo walled – houses to live in.


In 1951 Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru and President Rajendra Prasad had visited this camp. Primary schools had been set up under the super vision of the "Central Government Refugee Department." to provide the refugee children with elementary education. Both the central and the State Govt. had to become worried about the all - round development of the refugees who were ousted from their home land.

In 1960 the refugees of Cooper's Camp except the APL families got proposals for their rehabilitation. In many places like Dandakaranya, Andaman and Uttar Pradesh. After much thread bear discussion over the very matter the central govt. recognized the Cooper's Camp as rehabilitation centre and every family had been rehabilitated with 5 Kathas of land and 2,000/- rupees (two thousand) loan per family. The nomenclature as "Cooper's Urban Colony" was done in accordance with the name of the then famous military doctor Mr. Cooper. During the war of survival the locals had to snatch their ride by might. Standing against the government administrative system some times they had to boycott general elections, some times they held protest march up to the Writers' Building's all the way walking on foot with demand only to certify the Cooper's Camp as a notified area. There after the government has certified the Cooper's Camp as a Notified Area.

Along with the change of time the local people have realized the test of development. But all the families have not got their deeds yet. At the time of declaration as "Notified", it had also been declared that all types of development process would roll on. As to the declaration Rs.1 crore and 34 lacks had been sanctioned for this purpose. In the interest of Extension of education, there are at present one high school, five govt. recognized primary schools and six non-govt. primary schools in Cooper's Camp. As the high school has not been upgraded to higher secondary level, the local students have to suffer and go elsewhere for higher education.

The educational and health services system of this area have also to face the huge massive pressure of the population of the adjoining areas. As the Ranaghat Block Hospital is 5 km away from the locality, so the patients from this area and the neighbouring areas have to suffer many inconveniences. At present to provide a standard health service for that huge people of the locality, at least one "10 bedded hospital is most essential. Then it will benefit the patients a lot. Though there is

an outdoor at service, there is a huge lack of medications as to the requirement. At present health workers have been deployed by the Cooper's Municipal Authority to spread the mass conciousness of the chronic diseases as well as the function of observing the national programmes rolling on among the people in general.



Year of Establishment of Cooper's Camp Notified Area Authority: -

After the first election (1997) the notified area authority started functioning in the Relief Department's Building. The work of building infrastructure and furniture purchasing for the office set to working under the supervision of Manish Jain, the then S.D.O. In the year of 2000 the preparation of a new municipal building started. On 29th January 2001 the Chairman of the Human Rights Commission of the state, Sri Mukul Gopal Mukherjee, laid the foundation stone of the new municipal building. On 6th December Sri Mukherjee inaugurated the new municipal building. The people of Cooper's Camp are proud of the new municipal building which is the reflection of hopes and aspirations of the general people.

Demographic Growth and Population Projection:-

According to the Census 2001, the population of Cooper's was 17,755 and according to census 2011 Population is 18839. Population density is 12559. It is seen that population is increasing by decreasing rate. For last ten years it is seen that population has been increased about 6%.



Administrative Boundaries: -

Cooper's Camp is located at eastern side of Ranaghat Town. The nearby municipality is Ranaghat Minucipality of Nadia district. Nokari Gram Panchyet is northern boundary and Baidyapur G.P is eastern as well as southern boundary of Cooper's Camp Notified Area Authority.

Linkages of Rail, Road, Port and Air: -

The Cooper's Camp Notified Area Authority is 3 km away from Ranaghat, and 75 km away from Kolkata, the Capital of the State of West Bengal, can be accessed either by the National Highway No. 34, which takes approximate two hours to reach Kolkata from Cooper's Camp.

The Municipality can also be accessed through Eastern railway – Sealdah Division Main line, which takes approximately two hours from the Sealdah Railway Station. i.e., from Kolkata and the nearest railway junction is at Ranaghat, adjacent to the Cooper's Camp, which can be used as corridor for traveling towards southern and northern part of West Bengal.

The distance between the nearest airport and Cooper's Camp is only 70 km and it takes approximately one and helf hour to travel.

Economic Base: -

In the area of Cooper's Camp there was no provision for agriculture at that time. The Chief Minister of the then Bengal Bidhan Chandra Roy had dreamed of building some industries in this area and employing the local people on a priority basis and thus making the area financially developed. With this end in view the Central Govt. R.I.C (Refugee Industrial Centre) made acquisition of land and a ceramic factory was founded over there. A paper mill was also set up by taking lease from R.I.C. After 1977 the ceramic factory got closed certainly. Despite having the pressing demand of the local people, it has not been possible to make the factory functioning again.

At the living present the locals are mainly dependent on agriculture, cottage industry, bidi industry, government and non-government services and small scale business etc. to earn their bread and stand with high head. The local economy is being run by the local market after all.

Place of Interest: -There are no such places of interest. One and only Kali Bari is the main attraction for outsiders.

Festivals: -

Though lagging behind in matter of finance, the refugees here use to engaged them selves in cultural activities like Ram Yatra, Nemai Sanyas, Kirtaan, Theatre, Dance and Music and so many functions. But they always maintained the cultural heritage of the then Bengal. Even being a refugee, Mani Chakroborty formed a well organized dramatic opera. Latter on Sri Pradyut Chakroborty, the local administrator here use to play roles in the operas, theatres and deeply influenced each and every body. Except this Sri Deben Mishtri founded the Kali Bari for religious practice while he was local administrator. Foot ball. Kabadi and Volly ball were some of the popular games of these locality and R,T,C was a well organized foot ball team of that time. Following that trend at present "Chattra Yuba Utshab" is organized every year with the initiative of the municipality and with the aid of the state government, for the proper development of cultural harmony and raising the standard of sports and

games to a higher level. Every year huge number of local competitors take part in the well-organized competitions during these utshab. Overall sports have spread out in the entire area. Football and Cricket are the most popular games to the young people now a day.

Traditional Arts and Crafts: -

The wooden craft-making; embroidery; katha stitch; soft toys making; marketing of flowers;, woolen chaddar making by handloom etc. are the main traditional arts and crafts being manufactured in Cooper's Camp.

Climatic Data: -

Cooper's Camp is located near the river Churni.. The Municipality has a very tropical savanna type of climate, same as Krishnagar and is dominated by 3 seasons – summer, monsoon and winter. The summer is hot and humid and continues from April to June. Summer is dominated by strong southwesterly monsoon winds. Monsoon arrives in mid June and stays up to September. Winter is the most pleasant time and lasts for 2 months – Mid December to Mid February. Early morning mists are common in winter. The annual mean temperature is 26.8°C (approx). The maximum temperature often exceeds 40°C (approx). The temperature does not fall below 10°C (approx). Maximum rainfall occurs during the monsoon in August (306 mm) and the average annual total is 1,582mm (approx). Total duration of sunshine is 2,528 hours per annum with maximum rainfall occurring in mid July/August.

To give Pucca house for every family is currently on the global agenda. One of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) is to 'achieve significant improvement in the lives of slum dwellers, by 2022. Similar goals are set forth by Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana within year 2022, to create Pucca house for every family.


ULB undertake a demand survey through suitable means for assessing the actual demand of housing. While validating demand survey, Cities consider possible temporary migration from rural areas to the city just to take advantage of housing scheme and exclude such migrants from list of beneficiaries. On the basis of demand survey and other available data, cities prepare Housing for All Plan of Action (HFAPoA). HFAPoA contain the demand of housing by eligible beneficiaries in the city along with the interventions selected out of four verticals. The information regarding beneficiaries is collected by ULB in suitable. While preparing HFAPoA, ULB and Implementing Agencies also consider the affordable housing stock already available in the city as Census data suggests that large number of houses are vacant.

Bank account number and Aadhaar number/Voter ID card/any other unique identification details of intended beneficiaries or a certificate of house ownership from Revenue Authority of beneficiary's native district integrate in the data base of HFAPoA for avoiding duplication of benefit to one individual family. Beneficiaries is validated by ULBs thereby ensuring their eligibility at the time of preparation of the projects and approval of projects.

On the basis of HFAPoA, States/Cities subsequently prepare the Annual Implementation Plans (AIPs) dividing the task upto 2022 in view of the availability of resources and priority. For larger cities, HFAPoA and AIPs is prepared at sub-city (ward/zone etc.) level with the approval of concerned State/UT Government. The result of demand survey, draft HFAPoA and draft AIP is discussed with the local representatives including MLAs and MPs of that area so that their views are adequately factored in while finalising the plans and beneficiary list.

Cities which have already prepared Slum Free City Plan of Action (SFCPoA) or any other housing plan with data on housing, utilise the existing plan and data for preparing "Housing for All Plan of Action" (HFAPoA). Houses constructed under various schemes should be accounted for while preparing HFAPoA

The preparation of HFAPoA broadly involve Slum Development/Rehabilitation Plans based on

- a. Survey of all slums notified and non-notified;
- b. Mapping of slums using the state-of-art technology;
- c. Integration of geo-spatial and socio-economic data; and
- d. Identification of development model proposed for each slum.
 - Base maps to an appropriate scale would be a pre-requisite for the preparation of Slum Development Plan/Slum-free City Plan. States/UTs may need to proceed in the following steps for the preparation of Slum-free City Plans.
 - Securing CARTOSAT II/latest satellite images from NRSC/ISRO and preparation of base maps for the whole city and its fringes using the images;
 - 3. Identification and inventory of all slum clusters of all descriptions in the urban agglomeration with the help of satellite image and other available data;
 - Inventory of all possible vacant lands in each zone of the urban agglomeration that could be used for slum development/rehabilitation development purposes;
 - 5. Development of Slum Map of every slum within the city and its fringes using GIS with CARTOSAT II images, ground level spatial data collected through total station survey, collating spatial information with respect to plot boundaries, network of basic infrastructure like roads, sewerage, storm drainage and water lines, etc and superimposing this on the satellite image and importing them into GIS platform as the first step towards the preparation of Slum Development Plans and Slum Free City Plan.
 - 6. This may be undertaken with the help of technical partners of NRSC/ ISRO/other technical institutions.
 - 7. Identification and engagement of Lead NGO/CBO to guide and anchor community

- mobilization for the purpose of slum survey, (May be more than one NGO/CBO in different slum zones) of the city. These Lead NGOs/CBOs should also be associated in slum survey operations and dialogues for preparation of slum level development plans;
- 8. Conduct of Slum Survey based on the detailed formats (with or without changes) prepared by the Ministry of Housing & Urban Poverty Alleviation with the help of National Buildings Organization (NBO) after due training of trainers, training of survey personnel /canvassers and canvassing. It would be helpful for community mobilization to pick as many canvassers from the sourced slum or nearby slum pockets;
- Collection of bio-metric identification data of slum dwellers based on the above survey (subject to guidelines issued by Unique Identity Authority of India (UIDAI));
- 10. Entry of data from Slum Surveys in the web-enabled MIS application (to be provided by Ministry of HUPA), compilation and collation of data, preparation of Slum-wise, City and State Slum Survey Database and Baseline Reports. The MIS will assist in developing a robust Slum and Slum Households Information System. (Guidelines and software for development of the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);
- 11. Integration of Slum MIS with GIS Maps to enable the preparation of GIS-enabled Slum Information System that is to be used for the preparation of meaningful Slum Development Plans And Slum-free City Plan using a city-wide/zone-based approach.(Guidelines and software for development of GIS platform and its integration with the MIS will be issued by the Ministry of HUPA);

Allotment of dwelling units will be in the name of the female member of the . Alternatively, it can be allotted in the name of husband and wife jointly. Ownership of land required for every Beneficiary.

A EWS beneficiary family will comprise husband, wife and unmarried children. The beneficiary family should not own a pucca house (an all weather dwelling unit) either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India to be eligible to receive central assistance under the mission. EWS households are defined as households having an annual income up to Rs.3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakhs). States/UTs shall have the flexibility to redefine the annual income criteria as per local conditions in consultation with the Centre.

- 1. Water connection
- 2. Toilet facilities

Definition of Slum for Housing

Different definitions of a slum exist in different statutes and in urban poverty literature. For the purpose of HOUSING SCHEME, it is proposed to adopt the definition given in the 2001 Census, which is as follows:

- a. All areas notified as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration under any Act;
- b. All areas recognized as 'Slum' by State/Local Government and UT Administration, which have not been formally notified as slum under any Act;

'Slum' or 'Slum Area'— is a compact settlement of at least 20 households (For NE & Special Category States it is 10-15 households) with a collection of poorly built tenements, mostly of temporary nature, crowded together usually with inadequate sanitary and drinking water facilities in unhygienic conditions.

Situation Appraisal

The people living in the slums mostly have kutcha (10) and semi-pucca (186) housing. In certain cases where pucca housing is available, they are usually in dilapidated condition. The kutcha houses are in very poor condition and require extensive repairs. Most of the houses have tiles on roof. While during the survey some of the houses have been noted to be in average condition, the quality of these houses is also speedily deteriorating.

Proposed Intervention

In line with the vision to 'housing for all', an integrated housing programme is proposed to be implemented. The target will be all the slum /Non Slum dwellers in the pocket.

Building Plan

The buildings are proposed to cover an area of approximate 32 Sq.mt along with provision of 2 rooms, kitchen and sanitation facility. The layout, size and type design of housing dwelling units depends on the local conditions and the preferences of the beneficiary. The houses, has been designed in accordance

with the desire of the beneficiaries, keeping in view the climatic conditions and the need to provide ample space, kitchen, ventilation, sanitary facilities, etc. and the community perceptions, preferences and cultural attitudes.

In line with the scheme, carpet area of the house will be not less than 25 sq. mts and preferably two room accommodation plus kitchen and toilet should be constructed.


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


