Incidentally, it may be mentioned here that, housing demand in BLC mode as well as Infrastructure Development Work mentioned in the Detailed Project Report (DPR) as submitted by the ULB for the Financial Year 2015-16 was approved by SLSCM and CSMC thereon.

Since the fund has already been released from SUDA to the ULB is more than 70% with respect to total requirement for construction of approved number of Dwelling Units, you are requested to kindly arrange to initiate Infrastructural Development work immediately strictly adhering to the work specified in the DPR in compliance with the Guidelines under Housing For All Scheme.

You are once again requested to strictly comply with the Guidelines with respect to Construction of Dwelling Units, Geo-tagging and Infrastructural Development Work for the approved Households for Financial Year 2015-16 in a time bound manner.
