Therefore it is decided to provide two nos. 10 ltrs bins to every house hold of the model cities for the above purpose.

The specification of the Bins is enclosed herewith (CP-81-82)

Above note of the concerned Assistant Engineer may kindly be seen. As per Solid Waste Management Rules 2016 & CPHEEO manual issued by the then MoUD, GoI and simultaneously several directives issued by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), segregation of waste at source is the primary objective of each citizen.

Now, as per Order dated 02.04.2019 of O.A. 606/2018, of Hon'ble NGT, three cities viz, Asansol MC, Durgapur MC & Bidhannagar MC and the four towns, viz. Uttarpara-Kotrung, Haldia, Rishra, Baidyabati & Kalyani have been considered to be developed as Model Cities/Towns to comply SWM Rules 2016 within six months in all respect.

Thus, two meetings had been held, on 02.05.2019 & 20.05.2019, to let us know about their action plan. They had further submitted their Household with the model cities/towns

bin requirements in due course.

Now, as first and primary step to comply SWM Rules 2016, we may procure the Household Bins, as per the requirements placed by each of ULB, as given in NSP-1, 'X'.

The specification is also been placed in this file at CP-81 & 82.

Now, the file is placed for necessary approval of the same & oblige, so that the procurement of bin can be made from GEM.

The fund for procurement of the same is available in SUDA as per G.O. no. 176 (Sanction)/MA/P/C-10/16-1/2015 (Pt.) dated 27.07.2018 & G.O. no. 177 (Sanction)/MA/P/C-10/16-1/2015 (Pt.) dated 27.07.2018.






