

NOTE

All the ULBs of West Bengal were provided with Mobile Compactors with the Financial Assistance from SUDA for better solid waste disposal. Most of the ULBs have commissioned the compactors and started using them. The utilization of these compactors is now being sought to be monitored on a daily basis.

Municipal Affairs department now possesses a SMS gateway account through CDAC. Though the gateway is currently being used for PUSH SMS services, the gateway is capable for providing PULL SMS service also. It is now being proposed to use the PULL SMS service to collect the field data on daily basis from the ULB compactor operators. It is proposed to instruct the compactor operation of ULBs to send a SMS daily in the following predefined format: "nnn<space>x<space>y" to a predefined mobile no of the gateway..

Where 3 digits "nnn" will denote a code corresponding to the ULB

(We may number the ULBs from 101)

- 1 digit "x" will denote number of trips undertaken by the Compactor
- 1 digit "y" will describe wheter the compactor was half filled or totally filled. Character "H" or "F" will have to be entered in this field

If approved a PULL service titled "wb:cmpct" may be registered on the SMS gateway.


To activate the PULL service, an Website URL is to be provided where the gateway would deposit the received SMS'. As of date SUDA website is not yet operational. We may plan to use the MA Department website [www.wbdma.gov.in](http://www.wbdma.gov.in)

To collect the incoming SMS' from the gateway a rudimentary web service need to be developed on the website. Since we do not have a software developer in house and also since the above captioned website has been developed and maintained by an external agency Ms/- Telmac Engineering Enterprises to develop the required website and implement it seamlessly we had contacted the agency. The agency has provided a budgetary estimate amounting to Rs. 8,500/- + Tax . Proposal put in CP-1.The proposal includes provision f or 2 reports:

1. Day & ULB wise report
2. ULB code wise SMS list at no additional cost

It is proposed to get the above described services through Telmac Engineering Enterprises

The order to Telmac Engineering has been issued from SUDA on 3/10/16. They have started working on the software. We have also registered the PULL SMS service with CDAC and have intimation from them by SMS on 23/9/16 that our request has been sanctioned and we will be intimated once the service is activated. We are at the moment coordinating with the above two agencies and expect the activation of the service shortly.

In the meantime we should have orientation of the users (compactor drivers) on the format in which the SMS need to be sent. This is required as because, if the message is not sent in the correct format, message will be rejected. A sample communication for the purpose(mentioned below) has already been sent to you on 16/9/16, for your kind perusal . If the same is approved this may be percolated to the users through their supervisors and other concerned personnel. As I am not familiar with that set up , kindly advise how this orientation can be organized.

Sample message for orientation:

Gov of W Bengal wants to monitor performance of compactor. You have to send following SMS daily at the end of the day to 9223166166 in the following format  
**WB CMP 121 N F H.**

In place of **N** write total number of trips done during the day . In place **F** write the number of trips with FULL load . In place **H** write the number of trips with HALF load.

The PULL SMS service for monitoring the on field Compactor performance was put on stream from 20th October. The performance reports are sent through SMS by the respective supervisors. Though the number of SMS received started slowly, it has now picked up. For the last two days report for more than 170 out of 180 compactors, have been received. The reports are being analysed and being sent to Addl State Mission Director <sup>SBM</sup> regularly over email. **We can now say that the PULL SMS service is now working properly.**

While analyzing, we are able to find Compactors, which are doing no trips or doing only one half filled trip. As from the SMS gateway we can send bulk SMS easily, we may consider sending SMS alert to the respective Municipality Chairmen informing them inadequate utilization of the expensive equipment deployed in their ULBs.

Initially the Alert to be sent will be formed manually as there are still certain anomaly in the SMS received because of inadvertent errors in format being committed by some of the supervisors. These are currently being weeded out by manual analysis. Once the matter stabilizes we can eventually go for automated SMS Alert sent by the system

It may kindly be recalled that as per W/O no:- SUDA-217/2015/98 Dt. 18/01/16 & SUDA-217/2015/1836 dt. 30/12/15, there are 186 nos movable compactor, 21 nos stationary compactor & 17 nos hook loader supplied in different ULBs in west Bega. Accordingly HVA has supplied all the vehicles in time and payment for supply of vehicle has released to the HVA from SUDA as well as ULBs as per W/O. In case of 3 years of O&M of Movable Compactor, the HVA has provided services as per tenders. After obtaining of service report of movable & stationary compactor, SUDA has release the fund at wise to ULB and then ULB releases the fund to HVA.

HVA had submitted letters in different times regarding non-payment of O&M charges from the ULBs end and accordingly SUDA had requested to the concerned ULBs for release the payment to HVA. Now three yrs O&M period for most of the compactor except few compactor have already been ended. Recently HVA has submitted a letter vide no:- HVV/EST/19/18/11904 Dt. 18/11/19 <sup>(Flag)</sup> and inform the outstanding bill amount of ₹103 <sup>^</sup> nos ULBs as ULB wise till date. Among the 103 no ULBs, 43 nos ULBs (enclosed sheet) <sup>(Fig-13)</sup> are selected after discussion with HVA where they are facing problem to obtain fund and also ~~providing~~ pending for long days of O&M <sup>charge</sup> of compactor.

This is regarding release of payment to HYVA(India) Pvt Ltd against O&M services provided by them to ULBs for Stationery Compactor and Movable Compactor used in the municipalities for regular waste management since 2016-17.

As defined in the contract, HYVA is supposed to provide 3 yr O&M service to ULBs which is almost on the verge of completion. SUDA with the approval of the department provides this O&M cost to ULBs on getting claim of funds by HYVA. This cost is booked under SBM account.

Now it has come to our notice that a good number of ULBs is not making payment to the agency concerned though they have received requisite funds from SUDA for the purpose. The agency is repeatedly requesting us to look into the matter.

Since May 2019, several communications have been made to the respective ULBs requesting them to clear the dues of HYVA. (Details attached). But after repeated reminders an amount of Rs 3.16 cr is still lying pending at the end of different ULBs as detailed at NSP 17.

Now in a further reminder the respective ULBs may be cautioned that non-payment of O&M cost to HYVA without showing any specific reason may lead to defer release of schematic funds from State budget or under CSS as suggested by AMD in his note at NSP 14.

This is regarding release of payment to HYVA(India) Pvt Ltd against O&M services provided by them to ULBs for Stationery Compactor and Movable Compactor used in the municipalities for regular waste management since 2016-17 vide W/O no:-SUDA-217/2015/98 Dt.18.01.2016 and SUDA-217/2015/1896 Dt.30.12.2015

As defined in the contract, HYVA is supposed to provide 3 yr O&M service to ULBs and which have already completed.

As per payment terms and condition of O & M of compactors, SUDA will be released the fund to the respective ULBs and ULBs will be released the payment to HYVA.

Now HYVA has submitted a letter vide no:-HYVA/EAST/20/0306202001 Dt.03.06.2020(Flag-T) and it has come to our notice that a good number of ULBs are not making payment to the agency concerned though they have received requisite funds from SUDA for the purpose. The agency is repeatedly requesting us to look into the matter. They have also requested to release the balance fund directly to HYVA instead of ULBs to avoid further delay to collect payment from ULBs.

Since May 2019, several communications have been made to the respective ULBs requesting them to clear the dues of HYVA. (Details attached). But after repeated reminders an amount of Rs 2.72 cr is still lying pending at the end of different ULBs as detailed at Flag-T which has received from HYVA.

Earlier the then Principal Secretary has advised to ask ULBs to make payment within a week or adjust it against other fund payable to them which placed in NSP-19.

'X' As about 4 months are over after the reminder and still many ULBs have not release the payment to HYVA, so as discussed in a further reminder the respective ULBs may be cautioned that non-payment of O&M cost to HYVA without showing any specific reason may be adjusted against any other fund payable to ULBs and as per request of HYVA, for balance payment release to HYVA directly in place of ULBs may be considered under the present situation.
