

Sub: Sensitization Workshop cum Regional Conclave – Regarding Handholding Support for Preparation of City Sanitation Plans and Effective Septage and Faecal Sludge Management’ on dated: 18-19 July, 2016 at Delhi.

E-Mail dated 16.06.2016 from Programme Director- Water Management, Centre for Science and Environment, New Delhi in connection with the above subject addressed to Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal requesting for participation of the State Mission Directors for AMRUT and SBM, SPMG-NMCG as well as Chairpersons of the selected three Municipalities in the State viz. Bongaon, Bansberia and Darjeeling in the sensitization Workshop cum Regional Conclave regarding support for preparation of City Sanitation Plans and Septage & Faecal Sludge Management to be held in Delhi on 18-19 July, 2016 placed in file below may kindly be seen.

The Workshop aims at capacitating Urban Local Bodies and other stakeholders to help achieve convergence of NMCG-Namami Gange, AMRUT, SBM-ODF Cities’ programmes in identified towns by planning for city wise sanitation including non-sewered areas and identification of intervention for effective wastewater/ septage Management.

It is mentioned in this connection SUDA is SLNA for SBM (Urban) and dealing issues of ODF Cities in Urban area. Out of the other two programme AMRUT is dealt by CMU (Joint Secretary Municipal Affairs Department being State Mission Director) and Namami Ganga by U.D. Department, Government of West Bengal (Separate communication has been made to UD Deptt. by the Organiser).

Under the circumstances it is proposed that

1. Chairman/ Chairperson of 3 (three) selected ULBs (Bongaon, Bansberia and Darjeeling) may be requested to send representative in the said Workshop.
2. Sri B.N. Kar, Additional Director, ILGUS who is now associated with SUDA for implementation of SBM(U), may attend the Workshop alongwith Shri D. Sengupta, Technical Advisor, SUDA and one Officer/ Engineer of MED of suitable seniority (to be nominated by CE, MED).

It may also be decided for nomination of any other Officer of M.A. Department, particularly dealing with AMRUT Programme.

It is mentioned that cost of journey (Airfare /2AC) will be reimbursed by the organiser on submission of valid receipt.

As desired by Secretary a copy of DO Letter No. MD-SBM/AA/62/2016 dated 30.05.2016 from Joint Secretary and Mission Director, SBM, Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India addressed to Chief Secretaries of the concerned States has been obtained and placed in file below. It has been requested by the Ministry that the concerned Officers/Municipal Commissioners get in touch with Center for Science and Environment (CSE), an NGO retained by the Ministry for organizing a session of extensive handholding support to 29 selected cities on 18-19 July, 2016 in Delhi.

Sri S.K. Rohilla, Program Director, Water Management, CSE visited this Office on 05.07.2016 and discussed the matter in detail with the undersigned and Sri B.N. Kar, Additional Director, ILGUS. It was understood that the organizers desire that apart from representatives of the three selected ULBs (Bongaon, Bansberia and Darjeeling) the State Mission Directors of AMRUT, SBM and SPMG (West Bengal) State NGRBA Program attend the workshop. Since NGRBA program is being operated by the UD Department Sri Rohilla reported that he met ACS, UD Department with a request to spare appropriate representative from that Department to attend the workshop.
