- 1. WHEREAS, as per rule 16 (a) of the SWM Rules, 2016, the State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee shall enforce these rules in their State through local bodies in their respective jurisdiction and review implementation of these rules at least twice a year in close coordination with concerned Directorate of Municipal Administration or Secretary-in-charge of State Urban Development Department;
- 2. WHEREAS, as per rule 16 (b) of the SWM Rules, 2016, the State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee shall monitor environmental standards and adherence to conditions as specified under the Schedule I and Schedule II for waste processing and disposal sites;
- WHEREAS, it has been reported that there are several complaints/ litigations with regard to non- implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016;
- 4. WHEREAS, as per the rule 24 (1), 15 (za) & (zb), 24 (2) & 24 (3) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, following actions shall be complied:
  - •The operator of facility shall submit the annual report to the local body in Form-III on or before the **30**<sup>th</sup> **day** of April every year.
  - The local authorities and Panchayats shall;

Prepare and submit annual report in Form-IV on or before the 30<sup>th</sup>April of the succeeding year to the Commissioner or Director, Municipal Administration or designated Officer;

The annual report shall be sent to the Secretary-in-Charge of the State

Urban Development Department or village panchayat or rural

development department and to the respective State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee by the **31**<sup>st</sup> **May** of every year;

- 5. WHEREAS, as per the rule 24 (1), 15 (za) & (zb), 24 (2) & 24 (3) of the Solid Waste Management rules ,2016 each State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee as the case may be, shall prepare and submit the consolidated annual report to the Central Pollution Control Board and Ministry of Urban Development on the implementation of these rules and action taken against non-complying local body by the 31st day of July of each year in Form-V;
- 6. WHEREAS, more than 02 years have been passed from the notification of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and majority of Municipal Authorities have failed to comply with provisions of the Rules;
- WHEREAS, most of MSW dumpsites have been exhausted in a city/town, however, dumping of mixed MSW is continued;
- **8. WHEREAS**, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal upon hearing all the States/UTs passed order dated **20.8.2018** & **31.08.2018** in the matter of OA No.606/2018, in which it has been observed that the SWM Rules, 2016 have been notified on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2016, but implementation of the Rules remains a challenge;
- 9. WHEREAS, as per Rule 24(4) of the SWM Rules, 2016, CPCB prepared and submitted annual report on implementation of these Rules to MoEF & CC wherein serious deficiencies have been found in compliance of provisions of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016;
- 10. WHEREAS, Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 31.08.2018 in the matter of OA No.606/2018 observed that the States and Union Territories are nowhere near compliance of the Rules, 2016 inspite of the directions issued by this Tribunal. Even action plans have yet not been prepared in all the States more than two years after the Rules, 2016 have been in operation and inspite of binding directions in the Judgment of this Tribunal vide order dated 22.12.2016 in case no OA 199/2014 in the matter of Almitra H. Patel Vs. Union of India;

- 11. WHEREAS, the Rule 23 (1) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 specify the duty of Every Department in-charge of local bodies of the concerned State Government or Union Territory administration to constitute a State Level Advisory Body (SLAB) within six months from the date of notification of these rules;
- **12. WHEREAS**, out of 35 states/UTs, only 30 States have submitted the status regarding the constitution of State Level Advisory Body (SLAB);
- 13. WHEREAS, the Rule 23 (2&3) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, the State Level Advisory Body (SLAB) shall meet at least once in every six months to review the matters related to implementation of these rules, state policy and strategy on solid waste management and give advice to state government for taking measures that are necessary for expeditious and appropriate implementation of these rules. Whereas, the copies of the review report shall be forwarded to the State Pollution control Board or Pollution Control Committee for necessary action;
- 14. WHEREAS, the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the matter of Almitra H. Patel & Ors Vs. Union of India &Ors (199/2014) in the final judgment dated 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2017 issued order at S. No. 28 that "Every Advisory Committee in the State shall also act as a "Monitoring Committee" for proper implementation of these directions and the Rules, 2016;
- 15. WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board issued directions on dated 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for implementation of Rule 23–Constitution of State Level Advisory Body within six months from the notification of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 to all the Secretary–In-charge, Urban Development Department of all States/UTs.
- 16. WHEREAS, the Annual Report submitted by State Pollution Control Board in the year 2017-2018 has not been submitted by all the SPCBs/PCCs on implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. The last date for submission of Annual report was 31.07.2018.Out of 35 States/UTs, only 16 SPCBs/PCCs have submitted Annual Report (AR) till 15.10.2018. (Last Date

- 31.07.2018). The following are the observations on the Annual Report submitted by these states.
- Most of the ARs submitted by SPCBs/PCCs have not provided any data related to monitoring of the ground water around the landfill site or processing site.
- Most of the ARs submitted by SPCBs/PCCs have not provided any data/information on the ambient air quality.
- · Majority of the States have not initiated segregation at the source.
- Most of the States have not provided proper information on waste collection, processing and disposal facilities.
- Most of the States have not provided information about action plan prepared and submitted by the ULBs.
- Waste processing and disposal facilities in majority of States are not in working condition.
- State Policy and Strategy for implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, have not been formed by majority of States/UTs.
- Lack of coordination between Urban Development Departments (UDDs),
   Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) & State Pollution Control Boards/Pollution
   Control committees (SPCBs/PCCs) and other concerned Agencies, who are involved in implementation of SWM Rules, 2016.
- Most of the dumpsites are unscientific and operating without complying SWM, Rules, 2016. However, as per SWM Rules, 2016 Landfill site should preferably be used only for depositing inert waste and rejects.
- Mixed MSW is dumped on dumpsites causing environmental & health hazard and often lead to open-fires.
- 17. NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations on implementation of the provisions of the rules under Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to Chairman, SPCBs/PCCs & Secretary, UDDs are hereby directed as under.

### For SPCBs/PCCs:

- SPCBs/PCCs shall submit complete Annual Report in the prescribed format on implementation of SWM Rules, 2016 i.e., before 31st July each year.
- SPCBs/PCCS shall make provision for online uploading of Annual Reports by SPCBs/PCCs on individual websites.
- Interaction between SPCB/PCCs & State UDDs Departments shall be strengthened for proper implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 4. SPCBs/PCCs shall follow up with the municipalities and suggest setting up of waste processing/disposal facilities either by the municipality or by engaging private entrepreneurs and provide present status in the State.

### For Urban Development Department (UDD):

- At State level, a technical cell may be set-up to assist Local Bodies to enable them to initiate implementation of SWM Rules, 2016. States may evolve Plans and Policy to provide technical and financial assistance to the Local Bodies.
- Segregation of waste at source is to be made mandatory for ensuring safe disposal of MSW. Wet waste should be composted and dry waste should be sent to Material Recovery Facility (MRF) for further segregation & its usage.
- For proper implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, every State should finalize and place in public domain its Strategy & time target action plan.
- 4. Every State should follow the criteria for selecting a landfill site and setting-up buffer zone around a landfill and waste processing sites as per the guidelines and provide status of selected landfill sites in the State as per criteria of SWM Rules, 2016.
- The States/UDDs shall ensure safe disposal of legacy Municipal Solid Waste as per Guidelines issued by CPCB.
- Every State/UT shall constitute State Level Advisory Body (SLAB) and submit the status of compliance by 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2019.

SPCBs/PCCs & UDDs are hereby directed to acknowledge the receipt of these directions immediately and submit action taken report for compliance of the above directions to CPCB by **25.04.2019** failing which necessary action shall be initiated in accordance with law.

The Chief Secretary to Government of West Bengal and the Chairman of the State High Powered Committee under Mission Nirmal Bangla (Urban)/Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, the Secretary, Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal welcome all the members of the Committee and explained the overall plan and activities under Mission Nirmal Bangla (Urban). He made a detailed presentation on the agendas of the meeting.

Detailed discussion took place on the Concept, Plan and Process of the proposed Solid Waste Management Projects, Action Plan of all Components for the year 2016-17 including IEC & Capacity Building Plans, Claim of fund from Government of India in the year 2016-17 and Miscellaneous issues.

Salient features of discussions and decisions taken:

#### Solid Waste Management:

- DPRs of following 10 Solid Waste Management Projects of 14 ULBs of West Bengal have been placed before the Committee for consideration. The SWM Projects are technically appraised by Reputed Institutes/Technical Wings of the Government and approved by the concerned ULBs. Lands are available with the ULBs in each case. After detailed deliberation, the Committee has approved the DPRs of following SWM Projects:
  - a) DPR of four ULBs (in Cluster Mode) namely Dum Dum, North Dum Dum Dum Dum and Baranagar Municipalities.
  - DPR of two ULBs (in Cluster Mode) namely Habra and Ashoknagar-Kalyangarh Municipalities.
  - c) DPR of Jalpaiguri Municipality.
  - d) DPR of Krishnanagar Municipality.
  - e) DPR of Santipur Municipality.
  - f) DPR of Nabadwip Municipality
  - g) DPR of Bhatpara Municipality.
  - h) DPR of Naihati Municipality.
  - i) DPR of Kolkata MC
  - j) DPR (Phase-I) of Asansol Municipal Corporation.

Details of the Projects are placed at Annexure-1

2. It was decided that beyond the Government of India share i.e. 35% or as admissible of the Project Cost, the remaining will be borne by the State Government and ULB. This fund sharing pattern is approved in principle and UD & MA Department will finally obtain approval from Finance Department.

### IEC/Interpersonal Behavioural Change Communication:

3. It was discussed that the major challenge of the Solid Waste Management Projects is awareness generation through Interpersonal Behavioural Change Communication. For this, it was decided that a Combined Interpersonal Behavioural Change Communication Process will be developed by UD & MA Department and P&RD Department jointly utilizing the support of UNICEF. In this regard, support of the Department of Information & Cultural Affairs will be very much essential.

#### Annual Action Plan for the Year 2016-17:

4. The Committee has approved the Information, Education & Communication (IEC) Action Plan of Rs. 24 Crore for the year 2016-17, which has already been submitted to Government of India.

5. The Committee has approved the Capacity Building Action Plan of Rs. 13 Crore for the year 2016 17, which has already been submitted to Government of India.

amounting to total GoI Share of Rs. 424.79 Crore, which has already been submitted to
Government of India.

7. The Committee has approved the Claim of Fund amounting to Rs. 329.93 Crore from Government of India in the year 2016-17, which has already been submitted to Government of India.

### Miscellaneous:

8. It was discussed that a data base on existence of Open Drains in the ULBs should be developed and it was decided that a low cost scheme will be designed for covering those open drains in Urban Areas. In this regard, UD & MA Department will take necessary action.

9. It has been observed that the market areas & its nearby drains of urban areas remain very much dirty due to accumulation of wastes. For this, it was decided to prepare a plan for Cleanliness and Waste Management including drainage system in the markets of Urban Areas. Taking these aspects into account a new model of market may be designed and Kolkata MC will implement a pilot project in this respect. In this regard, UD & MA Department will take necessary action.

The problem of ineffective municipal solid waste management (MSWM) is prevailing in the urban environment of Bhatpara. DPR was framed to achieve scientific management of the municipal solid waste in Bhatpara.

Bhatpara being an important growing municipality, it is very important to maintain cleanliness and environmental hygiene in the municipal area. Due to unavailability of suitable facilities for treatment and disposal of the large amount of MSW generated daily in Bhatpara, the waste generated is majorly dumped into the immediate vicinity and thereby necessitate management of the MSW to accommodate the changes in its quantity and quality and to ensure clean environment of the municipality.

DPR framed has considered the following major aspects for management of Solid Waste.

- Minimizing Waste
- Maximizing environmental friendly waste reuse and recycling
- Promoting environmental friendly waste disposal and treatment; and
- Extending the coverage of waste management services.

Bhatpara is one of the growing municipalities of North 24 Parganas, West Bengal. The municipality is spread over 32.55 sq.kms. As per census 2011, the municipality population is 3.86 lakhs. The growth rate is about 2.00% per annum. The municipal area is developing at a rapid pace and the population is expected to reach about 4.29 lakhs by the year 2019 and 2025 about 4.536 lakhs. Bhatpara Municipality is characterized by a pattern of multiple land uses. Residential use occupies about half the area and commercial zones occupy less than 2.5%. Bhatpara is plagued by problems of informal sector including slum development, illegal colonies and commercial activities. The total area developed for urban activities constitute about 65% of the city area. At present, there are 93 slums having populations about 1.05 Lakhs. Present average generation of waste is about 320 grams per capita per day which will be about 365 grams per capita at the end of the year 2026.

Total waste generated at present in the municipal area is 160 MT out of which the expected biodegradable waste is 78 MT and recyclable waste is 20 MT. The non bio degradable/ street sweeping/ drain cleaning/ building rubbish is around 62 MT. Total waste to be processed at the engineered land fill is around 80 MT out of which 18 MT from inert waste from compost plant.

For the development of SWM in Bhatpara Municipality, the following components have been included:-

 Segregation of recyclable / non bio degradable waste at source by providing household/ community bins.

- · Effective primary collection of waste
- Transportation of primary collected waste to secondary transfer station and compost plant.
- Cleaning of drains

### Sub: Review of Krishnanagar city SWM PR

Dear Sir.

Thank you very much for giving me this opportunity to review the DPR on solid waste management system for Krishnanagar city, West Bengal. I have gone through the document and my observations are as follows.

- 1. This document is quite comprehensive in nature and gives all relevant data. Although certain sub-sections may be improved in terms of emphasizing on segregation at source, the document in general has underlined the importance of segregation at source. All waste generators including shops and offices and households have to adopt source segregation.
- 2. Municipality may consider adjoining clearance of construction debris with issuing the completion/occupancy certificate of the project (Sec 4.2), i.e. if a builder is not clearing the debris, he will not get completion/occupancy certificate.
- 3. In page 43 the proposed layout for a 5 MT biogas plant is good enough for schematic and representation purpose but there are certain inaccuracies and will be rectified as and when those projects are implemented. For example the main digester capacity is insufficient for a 5 MT project. BARC is capable of providing those technical details as and when necessary MoU is signed between BARC and the appropriate body at West Bengal state government.
- 4. Technological comparison at page 48 is the crux of this document. Composting has limited small scale application and should be encouraged at the housing society and housing complex level. Any housing society that practices its own biodegradable solid waste processing by composting should be rewarded by giving some concession on municipal charges (municipal tax, water bill etc. etc.). Waste to energy projects in any form (incineration or syn gas) are not sustainable and almost all efforts in India have remained unsuccessful because of space, cost, ash disposal and air-pollution. Engineered land fills have not yet been built in India but from international data available, it seems they are much more costly affairs than biomethanation projects. The advantage of biomethanation

is that the value of methane and manure produced tilts the scale in favour of sustainability.

- 5. Taking the estimate of 43 MT biodegradable waste generation in Krishnanagar city per day, the proposal to set up 8 plants of 5 MTPD looks justified. Space required for each 5 MT biomethanation project is approximately 400-500 M². The document assumes all eight plants in one centralized location. I would strongly encourage the stake holders to think of establishing those plants in a distributed manner all over the city. This will eliminate large scale transportation of waste all over the city. Waste transportation is a nuisance to the citizens at large. The advantage of having all the plants in one location is that if one plant goes down, other plants can take the load if any spare capacity is available.
- 6. The economics of biomethanation given in the document is broadly in line with the estimate given by BARC. However, it may be fine tuned as explained here. I MT of waste can give enough gas to replace one and half (1 + ½) domestic LPG cylinder. In case electricity is produced using the biogas using a 30KVA genset attached to each 5 MTPD plant then everyday one should expect 400 units (KWH) net per day i.e. net of production of electricity and consumption of electricity to run the plant. Using a changeover switch one can run the plant in a grid neutral manner.

The conclusion of the document that biomethanation is the most appropriate technology to pursue in a place like Krishnanagar city for processing of biodegradable waste is a very logical one and should be followed actively.

Subject: Appraisal of Detailed Project Report on Solid Waste Management for Naihati Municipality Prepared by Senes Consultant India Pvt. Ltd. on behalf of Naihati Municipality.

KMDA has carried out the technical appraisal of the aforenoted DPR and appraisal comments of the DPR is stated below.

The problem of ineffective municipal solid waste management (MSWM) is prevailing in the urban environment of Naihati. DPR has been framed to achieve scientific management of the municipal solid waste in Naihati.

Naihati being an important growing municipality, it is very important to maintain cleanliness and environmental hygiene in the municipal area. Due to unavailability of suitable facilities for treatment and disposal of the large amount of MSW generated daily in Naihati, the waste generated is majorly dumped into the immediate vicinity and thereby necessitates management of the MSW to accommodate the changes in its quantity and quality and to ensure clean environment of the municipality.

DPR framed has considered the following major aspects for management of Solid Waste.

- Minimizing Waste
- Maximizing environmental friendly waste reuse and recycling
- Promoting environmental friendly waste disposal and treatment; and
- Extending the coverage of waste management services.

Naihati is one of the growing municipalities of North 24 Parganas, West Bengal. The municipality is spread over 11.55 sq.kms. As per census 2011, the municipality population is 2.21 lakhs. The growth rate is about 2.07% per annum. The municipal area is developing at a rapid pace and the population is expected to reach about 2.67 lakhs by the year 2020 and 2025 about 2.95 lakhs. Naihati Municipality is characterized by a pattern of multiple land uses. Residential use occupies about half the area and commercial zones occupy less than 2.5%. Naihati is plagued by problems of informal sector including slum development, illegal colonies and commercial activities. The total area developed for urban activities constitute about 65% of the city area. At present, there are slums having population about 41,363. Present average generation of waste is about 330 grams per capita per day which will increase to 375 grams per capita at the end of the year 2026.

Total waste generated at present in the municipal area is 92MT out of which the expected biodegradable waste is 44MT and recyclable waste is 10 MT. The non bio degradable/ street sweeping/ drain cleaning/ building rubbish is around 38MT. Total waste to be processed at the engineered land fill is around 48MT out of which 10MT from inert waste from compost plant.

For the development of SWM in Naihati Municipality, the following components have been included:-

- Segregation of recyclable / non bio degradable waste at source by providing household/ community bins.
- Effective primary collection of waste
- Transportation of primary collected waste to secondary transfer station and compost plant.
- Cleaning of drains
- Processing of waste in compost plant by mechanical compost plant with windrow method together with engineered landfill.
- Movable vehicle at processing plant and landfill site.
- Beautification of the engineered landfill site with plantation of trees.

Naihati Municipality has 9.936 Acre vacant land wherein the mechanical compost plant of capacity 60 MT has been proposed in the DPR for installation taking into consideration 10 years population projection. The compost manure expected to be generated will be in the tune of 15 MT per day at the present. The land area available for engineered landfill 9.936 Acre which will have 10 years active life. Leachate generated will be reused in the windrows of the compost plant. Effective landfill gas management has also been included in the DPR.

KMDA has carried out the technical appraisal of the aforenoted DPR and appraisal comments of the DPR is stated below.

The problem of ineffective municipal solid waste management (MSWM) is prevailing in the urban environment of Bhatpara. DPR was framed to achieve scientific management of the municipal solid waste in Bhatpara.

Bhatpara being an important growing municipality, it is very important to maintain cleanliness and environmental hygiene in the municipal area. Due to unavailability of suitable facilities for treatment and disposal of the large amount of MSW generated daily in Bhatpara, the waste generated is majorly dumped into the immediate vicinity and thereby necessitate management of the MSW to accommodate the changes in its quantity and quality and to ensure clean environment of the municipality.

DPR framed has considered the following major aspects for management of Solid Waste.

- Minimizing Waste
- · Maximizing environmental friendly waste reuse and recycling
- · Promoting environmental friendly waste disposal and treatment; and
- Extending the coverage of waste management services.

Bhatpara is one of the growing municipalities of North 24 Parganas, West Bengal. The municipality is spread over 32.55 sq.kms. As per census 2011, the municipality population is 3.86 lakhs. The growth rate is about 2.00% per annum. The municipal area is developing at a rapid pace and the population is expected to reach about 4.29 lakhs by the year 2019 and 2025 about 4.536 lakhs. Bhatpara Municipality is characterized by a pattern of multiple land uses. Residential use occupies about half the area and commercial zones occupy less than 2.5%. Bhatpara is plagued by problems of informal sector including slum development, illegal colonies and commercial activities. The total area developed for urban activities constitute about 65% of the city area. At present, there are 93 slums having populations about 1.05 Lakhs. Present average generation of waste is about 320 grams per capita per day which will be about 365 grams per capita at the end of the year 2026.

Total waste generated at present in the municipal area is 160 MT out of which the expected biodegradable waste is 78 MT and recyclable waste is 20 MT. The non bio degradable/ street sweeping/ drain cleaning/ building rubbish is around 62 MT. Total waste to be processed at the engineered land fill is around 80 MT out of which 18 MT from inert waste from compost plant.

For the development of SWM in Bhatpara Municipality, the following components have been included:-

 Segregation of recyclable / non bio degradable waste at source by providing household/ community bins.

- Effective primary collection of waste
- Transportation of primary collected waste to secondary transfer station and compost plant.
- Cleaning of drains
- Processing of waste in compost plant by mechanical compost plant with windrow method together with engineered landfill.
- · Movable vehicle at processing plant and landfill site.
- Beautification of the engineered landfill site with plantation of trees.

Bhatpara Municipality has 10.50 Acre vacant land wherein the mechanical compost plant of capacity 95MT has been proposed in the DPR for installation taking into consideration 10 years projection. The compost manure expected to be generated will be in the tune of 20MT per day at the present. The land area available for engineered landfill 10.50 Acre which will have 10 years active life. Leachate generated will be reused in the windrows of the compost plant. Effective landfill gas management has also been included in the DPR.
