Sub.: Solid Waste Management of Durgapur Municipal Corporation – Reg.

Ref.: Memo no.: DMC/PW/1111 dated 24.07.2018 of the Commissioner, Durgapur Municipal Corporation.

With reference to above subject, the Commissioner, Durgapur Municipal Corporation, vide his letter no. DMC/PW/1111 dated 24.07.2018, has mentioned that the Principal Secretary, UD & MA Department, Govt. of West Bengal, on 10.05.2018, had requested him to scale down the capacities of the Plants already approved under 2nd State High Powered Committee Meeting, from Plants of capacities 100 TPD Dead Waste and 75 TPD Live Waste to 50 TPD treatment plant for Dead Waste and 10 TPD plant for Live Waste, as a pilot basis (placed at CP-197 to 204). A fresh DPR on Design, Development, Installation and Commissioning of Integrated Municipal Solid Waste Disposal System (iMSWDS) for the mentioned 50 TPD Dead Waste Treatment Facility and 10 TPD Live Waste Treatment Facility, had been submitted thus (placed at CP-1 to 196).

- Now, on scrutiny, the DPR Cost, as submitted by the Commissioner, Durgapur MC, had not been vetted by either the Engineers of the Corporation itself, or by MEDte./KMDA.
- The Estimated Cost of the Project, as mentioned by the CSIR-CMERI:

1.	Design, Development, Installation and Commissioning of integrated Municipal Solid Waste Disposal system (iMSWDS) – 50 TPD (Dead)	₹23,50,00,000.00 + ₹4,23,00,000.00 (18% GST) = ₹27,73,00,000.00
2.	Design, Development, Installation and Commissioning of integrated Municipal Solid Waste Disposal system (iMSWDS) – 10 TPD (Live) - Considering additional project alongwith 50 TPD (Dead Waste) iMSWDS project.	₹9,00,00,000.00 + ₹1,62,00,000.00 (18% GST) = ₹10,62,00,000.00
	TOTAL	₹38,35,00,000.00

Here, the total project cost, may be revised by 12% GST, against the 18% GST, as mentioned.

- In continuation, the Commissioner, Durgapur MC stated that the estimated cost is less than the actual cost of the Plants, approved in the 2nd meeting of SHPC, that was ₹38.7782 crore.

Again, he had proposed to keep the sanctioned amount of ₹25.5347 crore for the Bulk Procurement of equipments and vehicles.

- The revised project cost would be thus ₹ (38.35 crore + 25.5347 crore), i.e. ₹63.8847 crore.

- Now, it is required to request the Commissioner, Durgapur MC, first to vet the estimated cost of the project from the appropriate Municipal Engineer or from ME Dte./KMDA, though the scheme is vetted from the CSIR-CMERI, then to re-examine the GST part of the scheme, as mentioned, before sending the proposal to the competent authority for final approval.

7. A draft letter to the Commissioner, Durgapur MC have been prepared and kept in this file for necessary approval from His end.
8. If approved this may be sent to the Commissioner, Durgapur MC for further necessary action.
