Sub.: Installation of Screens on Drains discharging into the river Ganges.

The Joint Secretary & Mission Director, Swachh Bharat Mission, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Govt. of India, vide his letters under reference (placed at CP-4 and CP-10), informed the Principal Secretary, UD & MA Dept., Govt. of West Bengal, that the M/o. Housing and Urban Affairs to ensure installation of screening devices on all the drains/nullahs to trap solid waste entering into the river Ganges at least 1Km before it joins the river and the mechanism of regular cleaning of such devices. A detailed report may be submitted for such installation and its regular cleaning.

He also added that this ministry and the NMCG is also responsible for expediting and monitoring timely completion of the projects which are either under construction or at DPR stage in close coordination with the states.

For effective implementation, he had requested further that:

- Survey of all drains must be made for finalizing the places and number of screens to be installed.
- The state should ensure that these screens are cleaned as per a schedule and garbage is cleaned regularly.
- The state should ensure approval of all DPRs for SWM in Ganga Towns is completed by September 2018 and
- The state to monitor the capacity at which the working/operational SWM processing plants are functioning daily.

Now, KMDA had submitted a list of Drains discharging into the river Ganga, to the Member Secretary, West Bengal Pollution Control Board, vide its letter ref. no. 02/DG/W&S(GAP)/KMDA/NG-7 dated 03.07.2018, where it is seen that a total of 55 (36 points in the left bank and 19 points in the right bank) discharging points have been identified (placed at CP-15 to 19).

Scrutinizing, it is seen that some of the drains are in the jurisdiction of KMC, some are of KMDA and the rest are lying in the jurisdiction of either ME Dte./ULB/Irrigation Department.

For selection of Screens (Normal/Mechanical), width, height and construction/installation of the same, a single Detailed Project Report may be prepared by KMDA with help of the Member Secretary, West Bengal Pollution Control Board, the cost of which may be sanctioned from the fund of National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG). If sufficient fund is not available from the Mission allocation, the said fund may be sanctioned from the state budgetary provision.

If approved, a draft letter to the CEO, KMDA is placed in this file for approval.

Out of 55 locations which are the discharging points on both the left as well as right bank of river Ganges, the list of which has been addressed to Member Secretary, West Bengal Pollution Control board by the Director General, KMDA, it appears that apart from Berhampore and Jiaganj-Azimganj Municipality all other sites comes within the purview of KMDA.

As such for better and effective implementation for installation of screens on those discharging points, we may request KMDA authority to prepare a single detailed DPR in close liaison with the authority of West Bengal Pollution Control Board. Necessary cost to be incurred for execution of the scheme including preparation of DPR may be borne out of the fund of National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG). If sufficient fund is unavailable from the Mission allocation, the state may be requested for sanctioning of the fund, as required.

However, execution with regards to installation of screens in areas beyond the scope of KMDA, may be done by MED.

For the letter vide memo No. 4382 dt 03/01/2020 of Banberia Municipality, from the enclosure it has been found that 16 nos of Screens have already been installed at different outfalls to River Ganga, of all of size  $2.50\text{m} \times 2.50\text{m}$  and more. They have claimed an amount of ₹ 16,53,376.00 for installing 16 nos of Screens, but from a correspondence from the municipality dated 20th Jan 2020 via e-mail 6 nos of photographs have been received by this office where it reveals that none of the S/D drains are of the size  $2.50\text{m} \times 2.50\text{m}$  or more. The same has been discussed with the town planner afterwards and no confirmation has been made by him towards the size  $2.5\text{m} \times 2.5\text{m}$  and above. At various point of time the ~~same has~~ A.E of the municipality has been asked to submit some photographs of Screens having size  $2.5\text{m} \times 2.5\text{m}$  or more but till date no such correspondence has been received by this end.

This is to mention that this office has received above referred Memo. through e-mail from Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India on the subject matter cited above along with a Study Report based on survey conducted by GoI (copy enclosed) during Swachh Survekshan-2020.

According to their above assessment and findings, a large number of open dumps and GVPs have been found along the Ganga Ghats in some ULBs mentioned in the Annexure enclosed (Placed at CP side) and it is requested to urgently direct the official concerned to remove GVPs and open dumps near Ghats/along bank of river within the ULB boundary.

We may therefore request the Chairperson/Chairperson, Board Of Administrator of the concern ULBs to kindly take necessary measures to identify & remove GVPs and open dumps near Ganga Ghats / along banks of River Ganga within Municipal boundary in order to keep Ganga River clean.
