- (b) Strict observation of all relevant Financial Rules and Regulations including E-tender rules vide Finance Department Memo. No.6932-F(Y) dated 29.08.2013,
- (b) Timely completion of work to avoid escalation of cost,
- (c) Non-deviation of allotted fund from approved scheme,
- (d) Submission of Utilization Certificate of the fund allotted in due course.

No. 725/U.D. & M.A. dated 21.03.2018.


