Subject : Release of fund under Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) for restoration of
infrastructure damaged by 'Aila' during 2009.

M E M O

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to sanction payment of the sum of Rs.10,00,00,000/- (Rupees ten crore) only in favour of 59 (fifty nine) Urban Local Bodies, as detailed in the enclosed statement for, a) repair of damaged roads, b) deployment of man power regarding mobile medical team, disinfection of tube-wells and drinking water sources and removal of uprooted trees from roads, the Urban Local Bodies having been affected by 'Aila' during 2009 against the requirements as verified by the Municipal Engineering Directorate, West Bengal. The Urban Local Bodies should strictly adhere to the schemes as verified by the Municipal Engineering Directorate as well as to the schedule of rates indicated by it.

2. The District Magistrates concerned are hereby authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 1 above in T.R. Form No. 31 and disburse the same to concerned Urban Local Bodies within his jurisdiction, by transfer credit to the Local Fund Account of the said Urban Local Bodies with the respective Treasuries.

In case of Kolkata Municipal Corporation, The Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation, will draw the amount in T.R. Form No. 31 from the Pay & Accounts Officer, Kolkata Pay & Accounts Office-II, P -1, Hyde Lane, Kolkata - 700 073 after it is duly countersigned by the sanctioning authority and deposit the same to the Local Fund Account No. '8448-00-102-001' of Kolkata Municipal Corporation, by transfer credit.

3. The schemes are to be taken up by the Urban Local Bodies after the same have been vetted by the Municipal Engineering Directorate, which should also supervise the schemes and countersign the Utilisation Certificates.

4. The District Magistrate concerned are required to obtain Utilisation Report in respect of the fund sanctioned herein from the Urban Local Bodies, in the prescribed format, which has already been provided, and send a copy of the same direct to the Disaster Management Department and also a copy to this Department by 5th October' 2009 positively after satisfying himself about the authenticity & accuracy of the same.

The Municipal Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation, is requested to furnish a similar report to this Department within the stipulated time and manner indicated in this para.

5. The receipt of CRF in future will strictly depend on timely submission of the Utilisation Certificate, as indicated in the foregoing para. In this respect the guideline circulated may be referred to.

6. The fact of drawal/non-drawal of the fund by the Urban Local Bodies should be reported to this Department as early as possible.

7. The charge is debitabte to the head of account "2245-Relief on Account of NC-02-1s. Non-Plan-001-31-Grants-in-aid-02-Other Grants-V-Voted" under Demand No. 47 from the Budget Provision of Disaster Management Department. The excess expenditure over the budget provision will be met by way of re-appropriation or otherwise in due course.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Cr. 'N' 672 dated 29.07.2009 as conveyed by the Department of Disaster Management vide their Memo. No. 1447-FR/3F-08/09 dated 03.08.2009.
