Sub : Release of Fixed Grant in favour of Howrah Municipal Corporation - as compensation to the next of kin of the fire victims for incident of Fire at Foreshore Road within Howrah Municipal Corporation.

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to sanction and release Fixed Grant for payment of a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lakh) only in favour of Howrah Municipal Corporation. This amount is provided specifically to meet the requirements for payment of compensation to the next of kin of fire victims at 5/6, Foreshore Road, Shalimar, Howrah within Howrah Municipal Corporation that broke out on 21.10.2008 at about 9.10 p.m.

2. The Grant-in-aid being sanctioned herein above will be drawn by the Commissioner, Howrah Municipal Corporation in T.R. Form No.31 after it is duly countersigned by District Magistrate, Howrah. The Commissioner, Howrah Municipal Corporation will disburse Rs.1 lakh in favour of Nasir Ahmed, father of Late Sabbu Begam and Rs.5 lakh in favour of Asraf Ali, father of Late Afrin Khatun, Late Nasrin Khatun, Late Jasmin Khatun, Late Irfan Mahammad and Late Saddam Mahammad of 5/6 Foreshore Road, Shalimar, Howrah; on completion of necessary formalities.

3. The charge is debit to the Head of Account "3604-Compensation & Assignment to the Local Bodies and Panchayati Raj Institutions-00-200-Other Miscellaneous Compensation & Assignment-NP-Non-Plan-034-Fixed Grant to Municipal Corporations and other ULBs-31-Grants-in-Aid-02-Other Grants-V" under Demand No.39/MA in current year's budget.

4. Utilisation Certificate should be furnished by the Howrah Municipal Corporation in terms of Note-2 below S.R. 330A of the West Bengal Treasury Rules, Vol-I; directly to the Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal with a copy to this Department, as soon as the grant is drawn and utilised.

5. This order issues in exercise of the power delegated under Finance Department Memo No.850-FB dated 31.07.2008.

6. The Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal and others concerned are being informed.
