Subject: **Release of fund under Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) for restoration of infrastructure damaged by 'Flood' during August, 2011.**

M E M O

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to sanction payment of the sum of Rs.6,00,00,000/- (Rupees six crore) only in favour of affected 82 (eighty two) Urban Local Bodies, as indicated by Disaster Management Department vide their letter no. RL-248-FR/3F-06/10 dated 16.11.2011 (as detailed in the enclosed statement) for Repair/ Restoration of roads and culverts for meeting the cost damaged by flood during August, 2011 against the requirements as verified by the Municipal Engineering Directorate under this department.

2. The District Magistrates concerned are hereby authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 1 above in T.R. Form No. 31 and disburse the same to concerned Urban Local Bodies within his jurisdiction, by transfer credit to the Local Fund Account of the said Urban Local Bodies with the respective Treasuries.

3. The Repair / Restoration works are to be taken up by the Urban Local Bodies as per detailed vetted estimates and under supervision of Municipal Engineering Directorate.

4. The Municipal Corporations / Municipalities/ N.A.A. are required to submit Utilisation Report in respect of the fund sanctioned herein as per financial rule to this Department within 1 (one) month from the date of release of fund.

5. The fact of drawal /non-drawal of the fund by the Urban Local Bodies should be reported to this Department as early as possible.

6. The charge is debitible to the head of account "2245-Relief on Account of NC-02-Flood, cyclone etc.-193-Assistance of Local Bodies and other non Govt. Bodies/ Institutions-NP-Non-Plan-001-Assistance to Local Bodies for restoration of supply of Drinking water-31-Grants-in-aid-02-Other Grants-V-Voted" under Demand No. 47 during the Financial Year 2011-2012.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Gr. 'N' 1126 dated 29.09.2011 as conveyed by the Department of Disaster Management vide their Memo. No. RL-248-FR/3F-06/10 dated 16.11.2011 and as per F.D. U.O. No. 0673 dated 02.08.2011.

8. The Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, and all other concerned are being informed accordingly.
